WHEREAS, on September 29, 2022, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill ("SB") 1439 into law, making a number of changes to Government Code section 84308, a provision of the Political Reform Act generally known as the "Levine Act"; and,

WHEREAS, the Levine Act provides, in relevant part, that an elected officer is prohibited from taking part in a license, permit, or other entitlement use proceeding if the officer has received a campaign contribution in excess of \$250 within the preceding 12 months; and,

WHEREAS, an officer is also prohibited from accepting a campaign contribution in excess of \$250 during the proceeding, and for 12 months following the date a final decision is rendered in the proceeding; and,

WHEREAS, the Levine Act previously only applied to local governing boards composed of appointed elected officers, such as joint powers authorities or Local Agency Formation Commissions; and,

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 2023, SB 1439 amended Section 84308 to also apply to elected officers sitting on their elected governing boards or in their elected positions; and,

WHEREAS, given this recent change in law applicable to the Board of Supervisors and other County officers, attached is a draft policy for inclusion in the Board Policy Manual to create a policy for Levine Act compliance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey that the Levine Act Policy statement, attached hereto, is approved for inclusion in the Board Policy Manual.
