Receive a written and oral report on Governor Newsom and Legislative leader's proposal to reform California's Behavioral Health System through two ballot initiatives, AB 532 (Irwin) the \$6.7 billion Behavioral Health Infrastructure Bond Act of 2023, and SB 326 (Eggman) the recasting of the Mental Health Services Act into the Behavioral Health Services Act to modernize the Act, and an analysis of the impact on County Behavioral Health Systems of Care; the Board directed staff to send a letter of opposition unless amended; letter to include key points of concerns based on the impacts to the County Behavioral Health System of Care.


