The Monterey County Commission on the Status of Women (CSW) was established by a Resolution of the Monterey County Board of Supervisors in 1974 as an advocate for women in the County of Monterey on matters that particularly affect women, including affordable and quality childcare, education, housing, health, equal pay, sexual harassment, community services, and related areas.

The Commission represents women in the County of Monterey by informing and advising the Supervisors on these issues, problems, and conditions. Commissioners strive to fulfill this mission through planning, organizing and advocacy, capitalizing on a diversity of knowledge, backgrounds, and experiences.
