the Signature Authority to execute all documents.)

WHEREAS, Public Resources Code sections 48000 et seq. authorize the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (“CalRecycle”) to administer various grant programs (grants) in furtherance of the State of California’s (state) efforts to reduce, recycle, and reuse solid waste generated in the state thereby preserving landfill capacity and protecting public health and safety and the environment; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of this authority CalRecycle is required to establish procedures governing the application, awarding, and management of the grants; and

WHEREAS, CalRecycle’s grant application procedures require, among other things, an applicant’s governing body to declare by resolution certain authorizations related to the administration of CalRecycle grants; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors (Board) of the County of Monterey (County) adopted Board Resolution No. 20-008 which provided Board authorization for the Health Department to submit grant applications and necessary documents to CalRecycle; and

WHEREAS, the Board’s authorization for submittal of grant applications and supporting documents pursuant to Board Resolution No. 20-008 expired on February 11, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the County continued operations through the existing CalRecycle grant beyond the expiration date of February 11, 2025; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey authorizes the submittal of grant application(s) and supporting documentation by the Health Department to CalRecycle for all grants for which the County is eligible; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Director of Health Services or designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute in the name of the County of Monterey all grant documents, including but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and requests for payment, necessary to secure grant funds and implement the approved grant project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, this authorization is effective for (5) years retroactive to February 12, 2025.

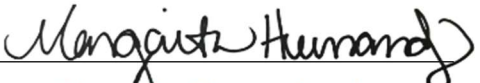
