- Automobile California Insurance Code Section 1872.8, California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2698.60 et. seq.
- Disability and Health Care California Insurance Code Section 1872.85, California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2698.95. et. seq.
- Workers Compensation California Insurance Code Section 1872.83, California Code of Regulations, Title 10, Section 2698.55, et. seq.; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors desires to authorize the District Attorney to submit grant proposals for the Programs, and to execute grant award agreements therefore; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors recognizes that as a condition of receiving such grants the County must agree that the State of California and the Department of Insurance will have no liability arising from the performance of any grant award agreement, and that the grant funds may be used only to implement the Programs and not supplant other expenditures controlled by the Board of Supervisors;

Compensation and Disability and Health Care Insurance Fraud Programs, including any extensions or amendments thereof.
