RECOMMENDATION:

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

In June 2019, the Board of Supervisors approved a non-standard Master Subscription Agreement with Zoom Video Communications, Inc. (Zoom). In February 2020, the County amended the contract to increase the number of Zoom Room licenses purchased, allowing ITD to enable more County conference rooms to have video conferencing capabilities due to the Covid-19 Pandemic work-from-home situation.

Zoom continues to provide all County departments with video conferencing needs. The Business Associate Agreement includes terms to ensure the County follows the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPPA), protecting sensitive patient data that healthcare providers, insurance companies, and other covered entities must adhere to.

Counsel for the Health Bureau and Natividad Medical Center has reviewed and negotiated the terms of the Business Associate Agreement.

The Chief Information Office recommends the approval of this amendment.

OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

County Counsel approves the Business Associate Agreement as to form.

FINANCING:

There are no fiscal impacts to the approval of this amendment.
