WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom was hired by the Monterey County Sheriff's Office in 2002, being sworn in by Sheriff Gordon Sonne on September 23rd, and over his career, served for four Monterey County Sheriffs: Gordon Sonne, Mike Kanalakakis, Scott Miller and Steven Bernal; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom was born in 1949, raised in the City of Salinas and attended North Salinas High School; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom came to the Monterey County Sheriff's Office after a long and distinguished career of twenty-five years working as a Teamster Truck Driver; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom has served as a Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer while simultaneously serving as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff, assigned to the Operations Bureau, serving the public of Monterey County in many ways as both a reserve deputy and Vehicle Abatement enforcement officer in all three sheriff's stations and throughout the entire County of Monterey; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom retires as a Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer as well as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff attaining the rank of Sergeant; and

WHEREAS, Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom has been recognized for saving the lives of two separate men by providing CPR and he has received a Meritorious Service Award, in 2012, for his work performance and received Deputy of the Month Award on three separate occasions during the years 2004, 2005 and 2014; and

WHEREAS, over his career, **Vehicle Abatement Enforcement Officer Philip Hickenbottom** received numerous other commendations from citizens, staff, numerous community organizations, and law enforcement agencies for his exceptional work, team work, and community commitment.
