WHEREAS, Public works services provided in our community are an integral part of the public’s everyday lives;
and

WHEREAS, Over its 170+ years of existence, the Public Works Department has provided multiple, diverse
services throughout the entire County, including, but not limited to the planning, design, construction, and
operations and maintenance of its transportation system, public buildings, grounds, and special districts, parks and
open space, landfill and water, wastewater, and stormwater management, emergency management and response,
and other important programs and services including the Five-Year Capital Improvement Program (CIP),
engineering and development services, County Surveyor, pavement management program, and litter abatement
program; and

WHEREAS, The health, safety, and comfort of our communities greatly depend on these facilities and services;
and

WHEREAS, The quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their planning, design, and construction,
is vitally dependent upon the efforts and skills of public works officials; and

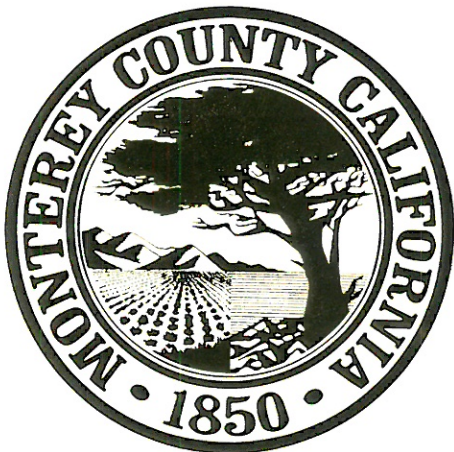
WHEREAS, The efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is

public works programs in their respective communities; and

WHEREAS, The year 2023 marks the 63rd annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American
Public Works Association/Canadian Public Works Association be it now.

County and all residents thereof, hereby designate the week May 21–27, 2023 as National Public Works Week;
