RECITALS

AGREEMENT

- 1. The Agreement (No. A-12169/MYA 265) is hereby renewed and amended as set forth in the Statement of Work for Professional Services, dated May 16, 2014 and attached to this Renewal and Amendment No. 3. The Statement of Work for Professional Services, dated May 16, 2014 is incorporated herein by this reference, except as specifically set forth below.
- Section 2. "PAYMENTS BY NMC" shall be amended by removing, "The total amount payable by NMC to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of \$1,350,000.00" and replacing it with "The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under Agreement No. (A-12169/MYA 265) shall not exceed the total sum of \$4,037,500.00 for the full term of the Agreement".
- 3. Section 3, "TERM OF AGREEMENT" shall be amended by removing, "The term of this Agreement is from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012 unless sooner terminated pursuant to this Agreement" and replacing it with "The term of this Agreement is January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2014 unless sooner terminated pursuant to this Agreement".
- 4. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the Agreement and Renewal and Amendment No.1, Amendment No. 2 are unchanged and unaffected by this Renewal and Amendment No. 3 and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the Agreement.
- A copy of this Renewal and Amendment No. 3 and all previous Amendments shall be attached to the original Agreement (No. A-12169/MYA 265).
- 6. The effective date of this Renewal and Amendment No. 3 is January 1, 2014.
