a. Receive a preliminary response to Board Referral 2024.15 (Alejo/Lopez) regarding the creation of a Monterey County Immigrants' Rights Ad Hoc Committee that will bring together key immigrant community stakeholders that could make recommendations, enhance communication and assist the County of Monterey in preparing and protecting our immigrant community in Monterey County against any unconstitutional and draconian federal actions in which Supervisor Luis A. Alejo and Supervisor Chris Lopez will serve on; and

b. Provided direction to staff to print Know Your Right cards and forms, update the Welcome Resolution in January 2025, have County Counsel look into Federal litigation efforts, have California State Association of Counties (CSAC) look into an immigration working group between concerned counties and have the Legislative Committee send out the letter discussed in their meeting.
