Dear Chad,

As requested this letter shall serve as a written request to extend the Subdivision Improvement Agreement (S.I.A.) for the Cathrein Ranch Subdivision project, Planning File PLN990330, and the grading permit associated with that Agreement.

The grading work and the installation of other infrastructure improvements have continued since the Agreement was executed; the work has been observed, inspected and document by Landset Engineers. Copies of the 52 field reports completed by the engineer to date are on file with the County Building and Environmental Services Departments.

As discussed attached is the revised Engineer's Estimate. Based on work completed to date, the value of the bonds currently in place exceed expected cost to complete by over \$400,000.00. Discussion regarding decreasing the bonds can be postponed to a later date. We ask that your primary focus be on allowing work to continue, which requires an active grading permit and extended Subdivision Improvement Agreement. We ask that the S.I. A. be extended for a two year period. Lastly regarding inspection fees, a review of the grading permit records shall confirm that we have not exceeded the expected time allocated for inspections, so no additional inspection fees should be warranted.

It should be noted that the Subdivision Improvement Agreement executed and recorded on September 13, 2013 included the signatures of William M. Kelley and Nicole F. Kelley the previous owners of Open Parcel "C" (APN 125-291-049). Catherein Land LLC has since purchased that property from the Kelley's (Deed recorded 1/31/2014 doc No. 2014004643).

We appreciate your time and assistance in this matter.
