WHEREAS, the Constitution stands as a testament to the enduring principles of freedom, democracy, and the rule of law that have guided our nation for over two centuries; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary and to encourage all citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution envisioned in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County and all its residents thereof, does hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through 23 as Constitution Week in Monterey County, and urges all residents to study the Constitution and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities that come with this privilege.
