<b>WHEREAS</b> , <i>Manuel Infante</i> , District Attorney Investigator III, retired on December 13, 2013 after completing 23 years of outstanding service to the County of Monterey; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , <i>Manuel Infante</i> began his 27 year career in law enforcement as a correctional officer with the San Benito County Sheriff's Office on January 7, 1986. During this time he gained experience as a senior correctional officer. In 1987, this experience led to a promotion to Deputy Sherriff. He was recognized as being a skilled supervisor/leader in interview and interrogation techniques and as a Reserve Deputy Coordinator; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , in March of 1990 <i>Manuel Infante</i> was hired as a District Attorney Investigator I working in the Welfare Fraud Division. In October of 1996, he was promoted to a District Attorney Investigator II and was assigned to the Child Abduction Unit. In February of 1998, he was promoted to District Attorney Investigator III, a position he held until his retirement on December 14, 2013; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , <i>Manuel Infante</i> was one of the first Monterey County District Attorney Investigators to be promoted from Investigator I to Investigator III, working all three classifications; and
<b>WHEREAS</b> , for the past 27 years, <i>Manuel Infante</i> has dedicated his professional life to public service, 4 years as a sworn peace officer with the San Benito County Sheriff's Office, and 23 years as an investigator with the Monterey County District Attorney's Office. During which he has worked in various units to include: Welfare Fraud Unit, Child Abduction Unit, Family Support Division, Statutory Rape Unit, Auto Fraud/Workers Compensation Fraud Unit and General Crimes Unit. During that time, he has successfully investigated a wide spectrum of cases and has served on several task forces as the lead investigator; and
