- b. Set and hold a Public Hearing date on June 6, 2017 at 1:30 PM to consider adopting assessment rate charges with a 3.5% increase for Zone 2C Operations and Maintenance of Nacimiento and San Antonio Dams, and Administration; and
- c. Directed the Clerk of the Board to publish a hearing notice in the Salinas Californian or Monterey County Weekly at least ten (10) days prior to the date set for the hearing.
