**WHEREAS**, The Monterey County Health Department with administrative services located at 1270 Natividad Road, Salinas, CA 93906, is nationally accredited and serves over 430,000 Monterey County residents with a broad range of health care and promotion services through its nearly 1,273 employees organized in seven (7) Bureaus; and

**WHEREAS**, County receives health realignment funds from the State of California to provide various services in the areas of communicable disease, chronic disease prevention, immunizations, maternal and adolescent health, public nursing, and direct health services to indigents in the County; and

**WHEREAS**, County believes that partnering with a local primary care provider of medical services is an effective strategy to promote and facilitate access to medical care to low-income Monterey County residents with access-to-care challenges; and

**WHEREAS**, Mee Memorial is a 94-bed medical facility located at 300 Canal Street, King City, CA 93930, Mee Memorial operates three (3) rural health clinics (RHC); King City Clinic, Greenfield Clinic, and the Children’s Health and Wellness Center, providing primary care and healthcare examinations with over 66,000 visits annually with an established history of providing primary care in Monterey County to a population with access-to-care challenges; and

**WHEREAS**, The Monterey County Health Department desires to provide a public health grant to Mee Memorial to reimburse some of the operational costs of providing medical services for clients with access-to-care challenges residing in King City and the surrounding area; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey, that the expenditure of funds from the County of Monterey Health Department (“Health”) Fiscal Year (FY) 2025-26, FY 2026-27, and FY 2027-28 Budgets, to support a Funding Agreement, assisting Southern Monterey County Memorial

Hospital, DBA George L. Mee Memorial Hospital (“Mee Memorial”) in meeting the direct operational costs of providing medical services to the clients residing in King City and the surrounding area of South Monterey County area, has a direct and primary public purpose, benefiting Monterey County, in general, and Health, in particular.


