WHEREAS, Coast Guard Station Monterey personnel and the Monterey Coast Guard Auxiliary Flotilla have worked together all year to increase boating safety awareness in Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey Flotilla has conducted numerous, free Vessel Safety Checks on boats and personal water craft in Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey Flotilla has presented Water Safety Presentations to public elementary schools; and

WHEREAS, an Auxiliary Marine Patrol with Monterey Flotilla members present, saved the life of a sailor who had capsized, broken her wrist and was suffering from hypothermia; and

WHEREAS, the Monterey Flotilla will continue its efforts to patrol Monterey Bay, educate the boating public by offering boating classes and free vessel examinations, promote safe boating and encourage the wearing of life jackets.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey on behalf of the County and all the citizens thereof, hereby designate the week of May 17 through May 23, 2014 as “**National Safe Boating Week**” in Monterey County and urges all users of ALL in-land lakes, rivers, and the Pacific Coastal area to safeguard their lives by wearing life jackets when boating, attend a safe boating course exercise safe boating practices, and adopt the slogan of “WEAR IT”.
