Fund 116 Current Budget Status

- FY25 Adopted Budget of Fund 116 - planned use of Fund balance of \$2.9 million to cover the gap of total expenditures and revenues.
- FY25 Starting Fund Balance
 - FY25 budget was developed, assuming \$3.93 million
 - The actual amount is estimated at \$1.85 million
 - Major factors - \$900K strategic reserve transfer to Fund 112
 - Increased repair activities funded by fund balance
- Concerned that this may result in a negative Fund Balance by the FY25 year-end if all FY25 activities & costs were at the budgeted level
- Staff continue to review & monitor the situation and will provide recommendations to remedy the Fund Balance deficit if needed.

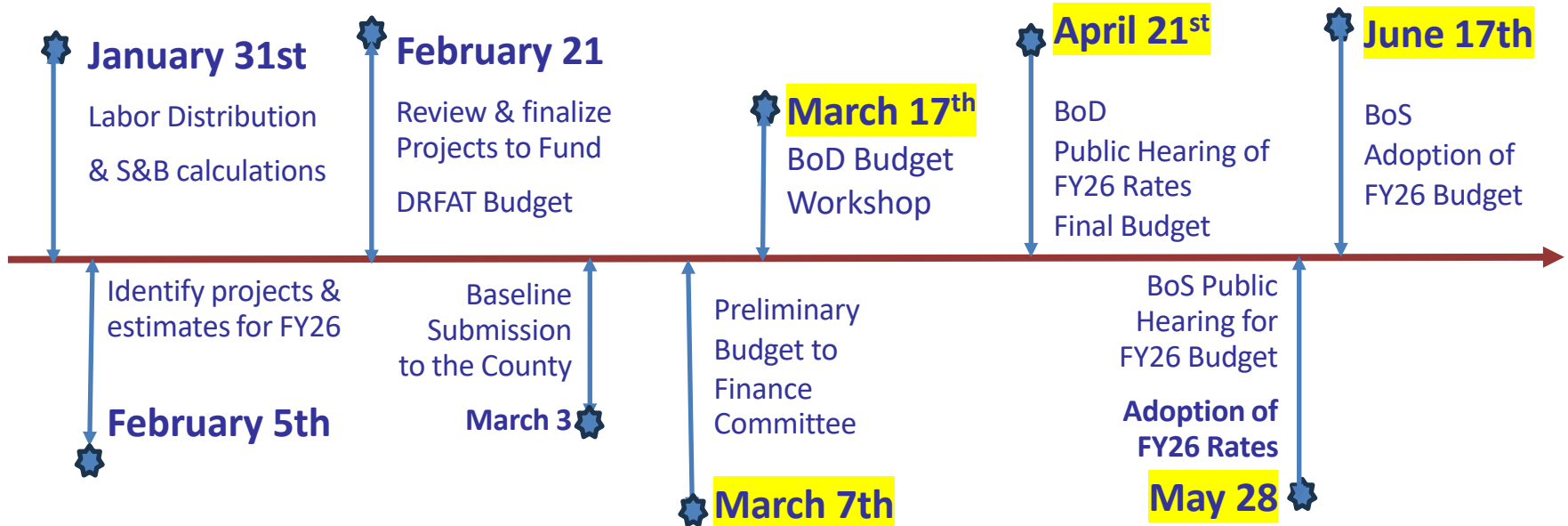

Reservoir Storage & Release Update

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The Board of Directors receives monthly updates on the status of Agency reservoirs.

RESERVOIR ELEVATION / STORAGE: As of January 21, 2025, San Antonio Reservoir has a water surface elevation of approximately 759.25 feet (NGVD 29), with 233,013 acre-feet of water in storage. Nacimiento Reservoir has a water surface elevation of approximately 762.60 feet, with 197,170 acre-feet of water in storage. San Antonio Reservoir is currently at 70% of storage capacity and Nacimiento Reservoir is at 52% of capacity.

RESERVOIR RELEASES: Minimum fisheries releases have continued to be made from both reservoirs since the end of conservation releases in October.

RAINFALL: No significant rainfall has been recorded in January. Rainfall in mid-December produced minor inflow to Nacimiento Reservoir.

SALINAS LAGOON: The lagoon has been closed to the ocean since July 11, 2024.

Releases as of the morning of January 21, 2024:

- Nacimiento Reservoir: 67 cfs
- San Antonio Reservoir: 10 cfs

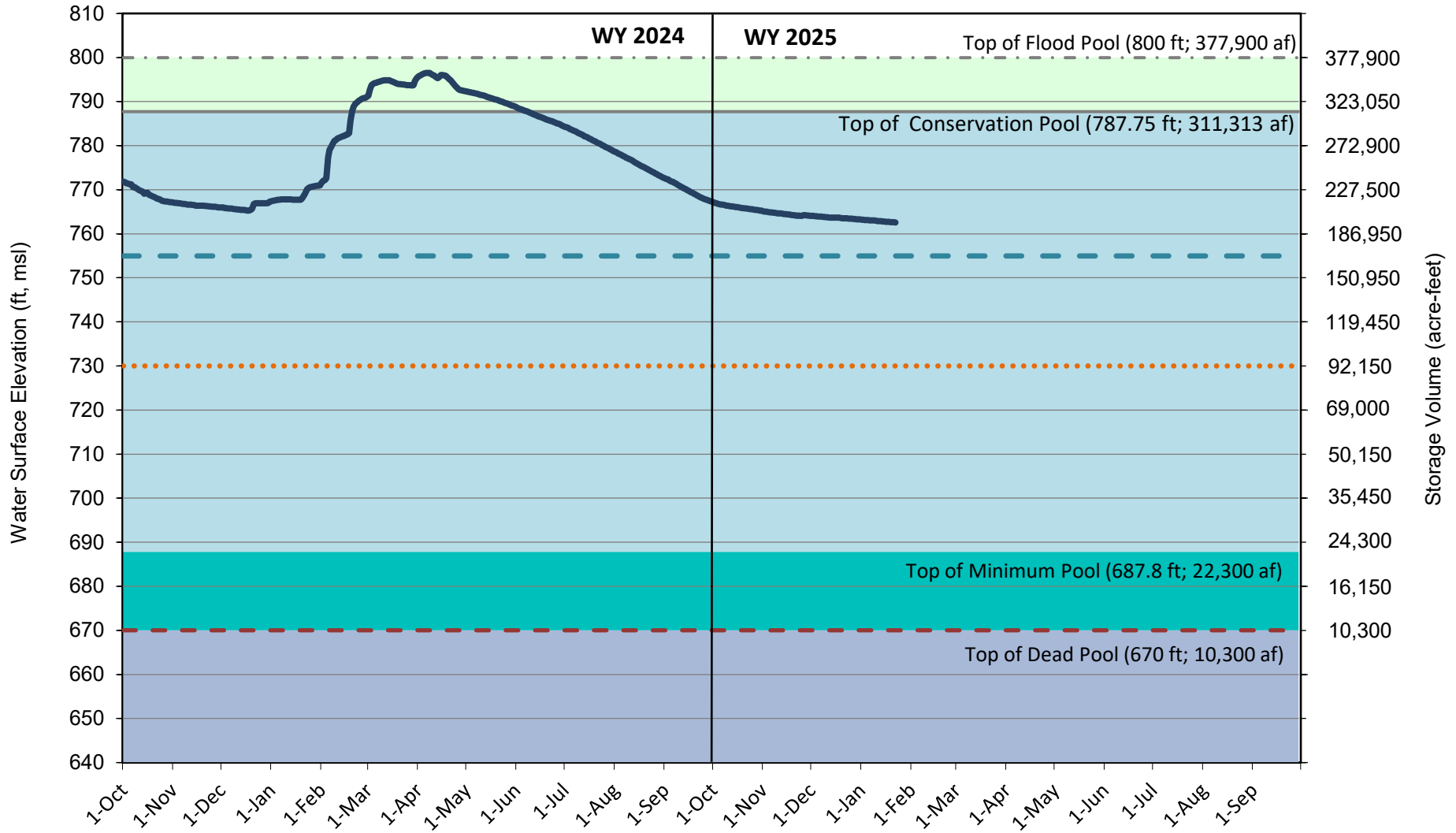
Total releases from both reservoirs to the Salinas River are approximately 77 cfs. The following “provisional” flows have been recorded by the USGS:

- Salinas River near Bradley: 74 cfs
- Salinas River at Soledad: 22 cfs
- Salinas River near Chualar: No flow
- Salinas River near Spreckels: No flow

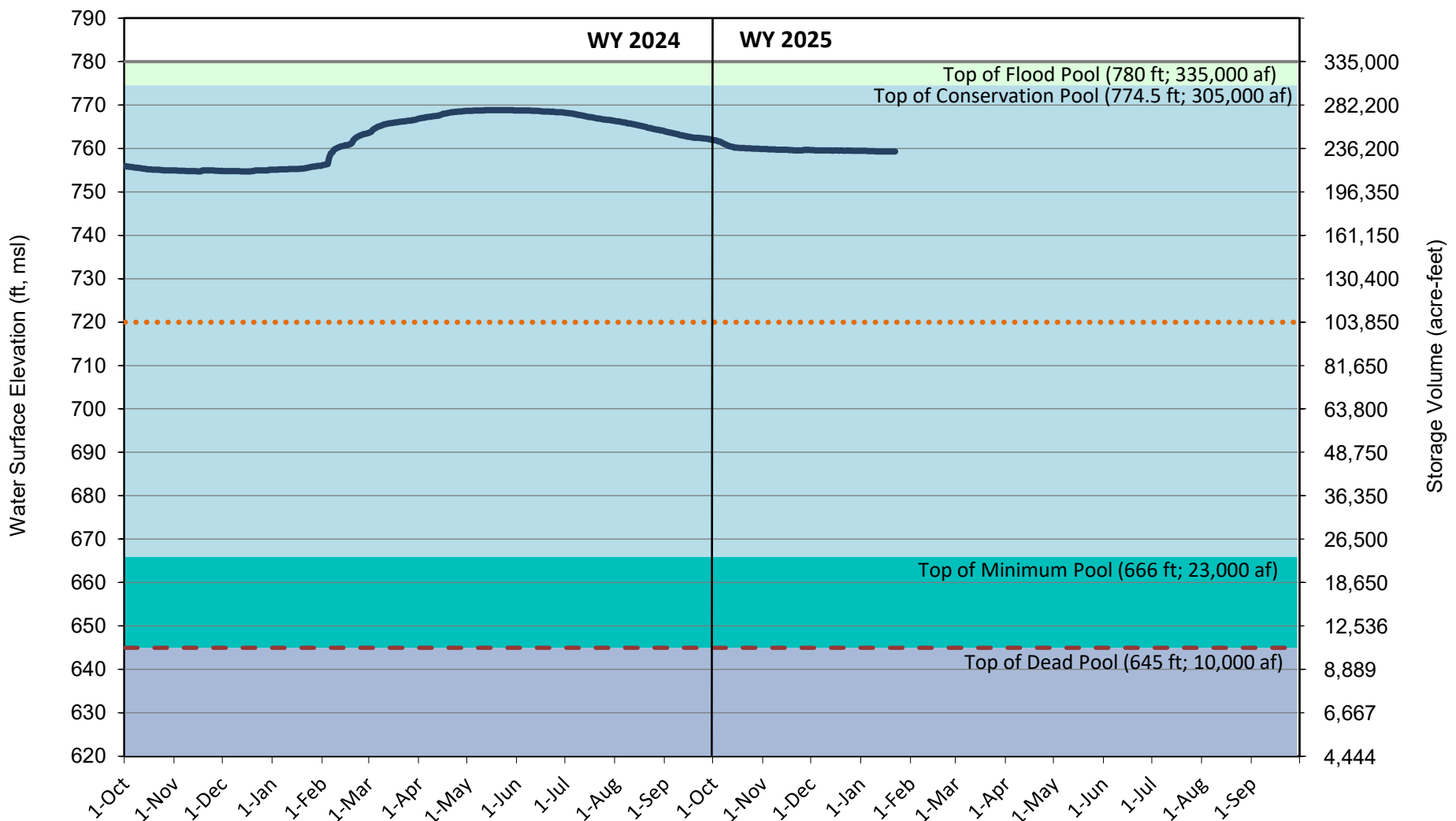

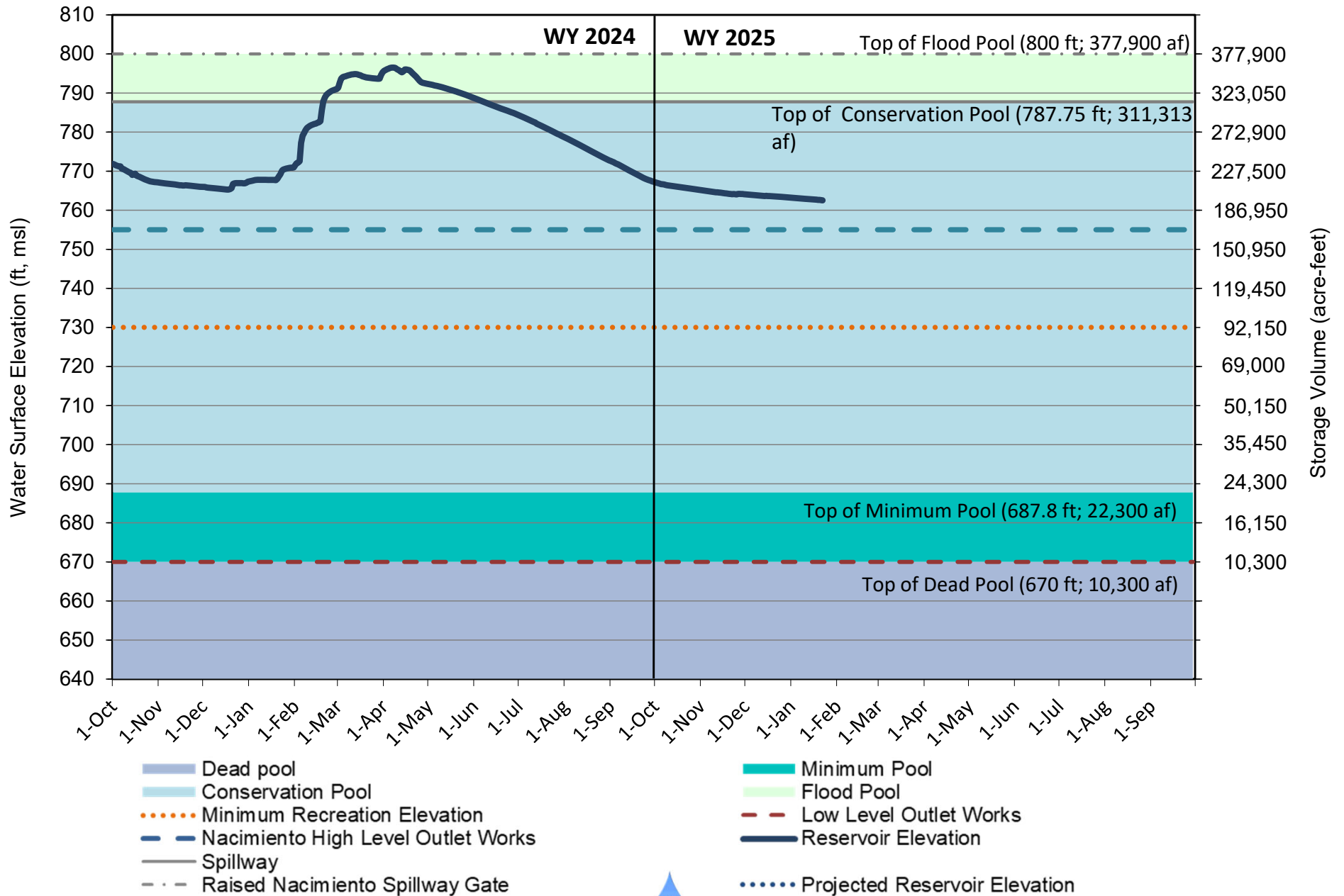


Current Reservoir Conditions (1/22/25)

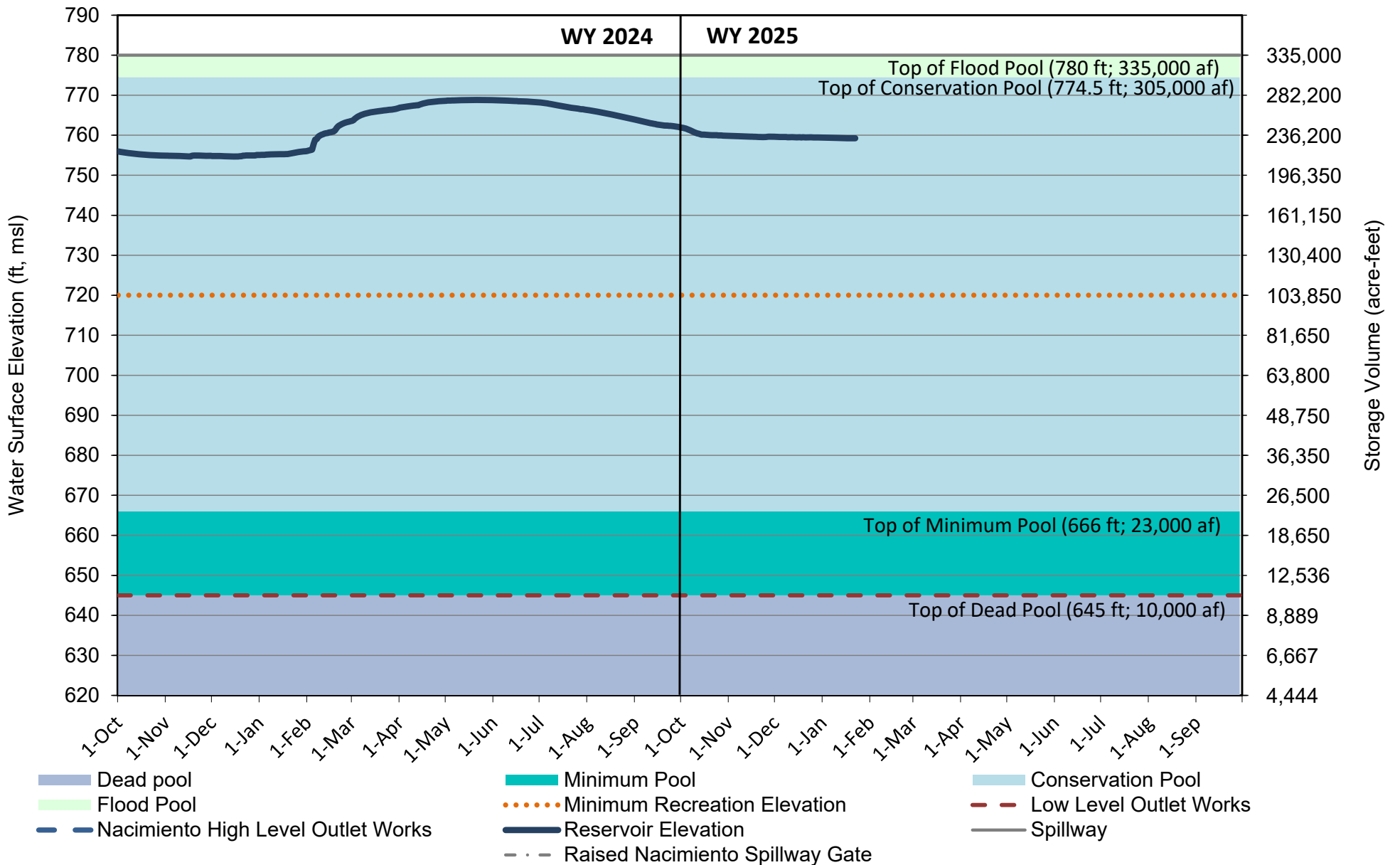

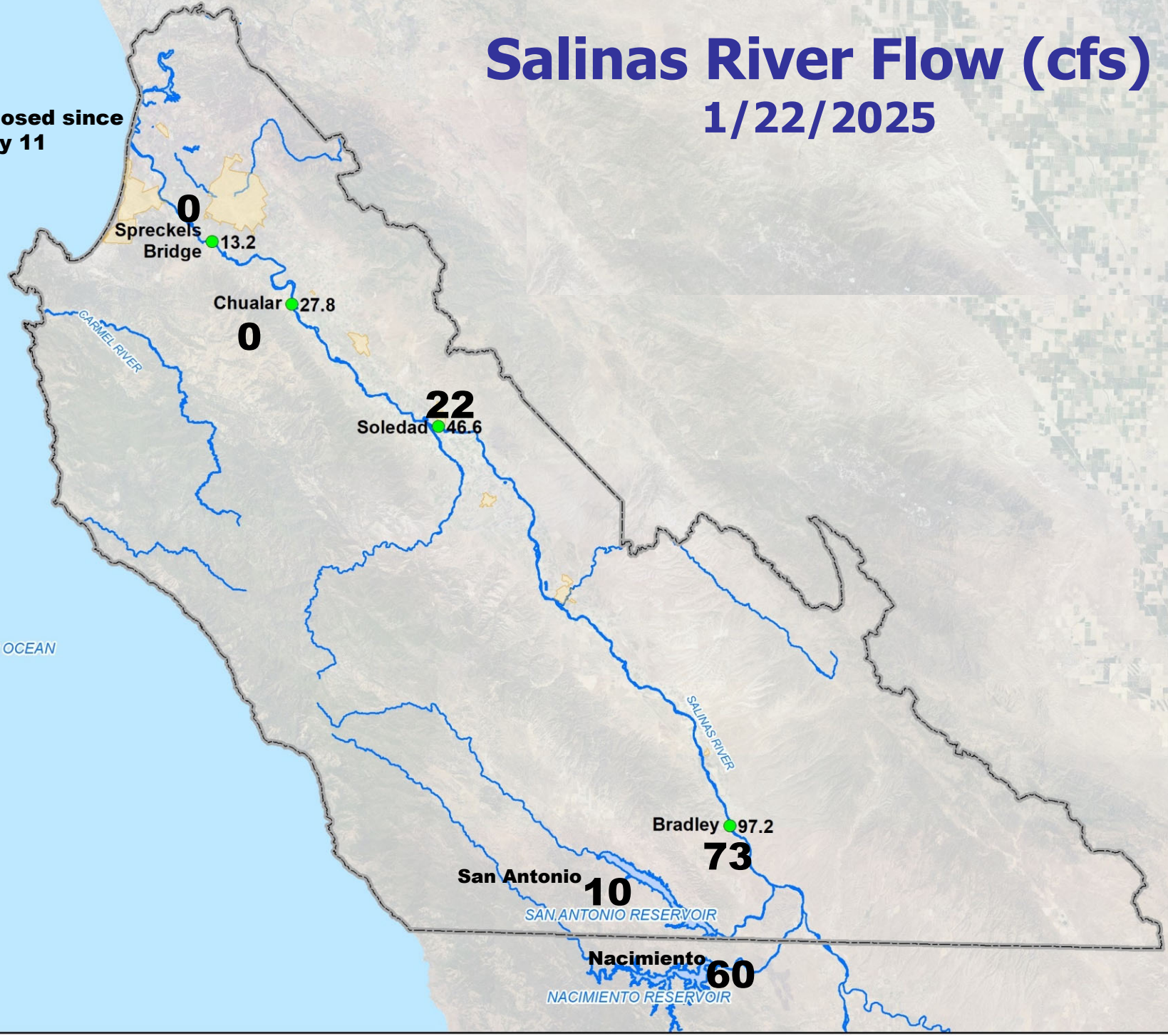
