Payroll Deductions for United Crusade-)
American Red Cross Approved)

Dr. J. Frederic Ching, Chairman of the United Crusade, appears before the Board to request payroll deductions for County employees for the United Crusade-Red Cross campaign.

Discussion is had on the manner in which contributions would be made and the designation of said donations to various organizations.

Walter S. Mansfield, Administrative Officer, suggests only one deduction be authorized for charitable organizations. He informs the Board that the County Auditor-Controller recommends only one deduction be made and only one warrant drawn for the Agency each month.

After further discussion, Supervisor Henry moves that payroll deduction be authorized for United Crusade-American Red Cross and that the Auditor be directed to draw one warrant only to said Agency each month. Supervisor Atteridge seconds the motion, with the condition that this be strictly a voluntary program for the employees and that if other organizations request similar deductions the County cancel the payroll plan for United Crusade-American Red Cross.
