WHEREAS, the Human Resources Department completed a base wage compensation study of the Deputy Sheriff-Operations classification and found that its base wage salary is approximately 8.12% below the salary mean of the County's comparable agencies' classifications; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended to adjust the base wage salary of the Deputy Sheriff-Operations classification by approximately 8.12% at top step in order to align it with the labor market average; and

WHEREAS, to implement the recommendations, the action requires the Personnel Policies and Practices Resolution No. 98-394 Appendix A to be amended;
