Approve and authorize the Chief Executive Officer for Natividad Medical Center or a designee to execute up to three (3) future amendments that do not exceed 10% (\$21,000) of the original agreement, do not significantly change the scope of services, and do not increase the total not to exceed amount over \$231,000.

FINANCING:

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The cost for this agreement is \$210,000 of which \$150,000 which is included in the FY 2025-26 Adopted Budget. Amounts for remaining years of the agreement will be included in those budgets as appropriate. There is no impact on the General Fund with this action.
