**WHEREAS,** relatively recent approvals to increase the Maintenance of Effort (MOE) for Road Fund by increasing the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) proportion to the County Road Fund in FY 2024-25 to 25% of the County's total TOT, have resulted in increased revenues for funding road purposes to the County; and

**WHEREAS,** the additional amount of TOT beyond previous Fiscal Years, has been designated for use for the Local Road Rehabilitation Program v.2.0, consistent with the County Board Policy G-135 Local Road Rehabilitation Program v.2.0 Policy; and

**WHEREAS,** in evaluating the current workload, the existing Public Works, Facilities and Parks (PWFP) Road/Bridge Project staffing is at capacity and delivering the maximum number of road infrastructure projects given available staffing; and

**WHEREAS,** a PWFP Engineering staff member must still manage contracted resources (consultants and contractors). Additionally, it is envisioned that this position will also assist with the preparation of Engineer's Reports and management of the Prop 218 rate increase processes for various County Service Areas (CSAs); and

**WHEREAS,** the County is the recipient of outside one-time funding sources. PWFP is managing two Federal Earmarks and a State planning grant from the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB). Federal Earmark for Pajaro County Sanitation District (PCSD) was awarded the end of FY 2023-24, for approximately \$1.5 million; and

**WHEREAS**, the new classification will allow the PWFP Engineering Team to implement these specialized road repair projects and one-time grant funded projects.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** the Monterey County Board of Supervisors hereby resolved to approve the following:

1. The Public Works, Facilities and Parks Department (PWFP) Fund 002, Budget Unit 8558 - Appropriation Unit PFP004 is amended to add one (1) FTE Senior Civil Engineer and increase appropriations by \$252,393 funded by the Road Fund (4/5<sup>th</sup> vote required), as indicated below:
