#### **Resolution No.: 14-087**

The 2012 and 2013 Annual Reports for the County of Monterey Condition of Approval and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (REF140016) came on for public hearing before the Monterey County Board of Supervisors on March 25, 2014. Having considered all the written and documentary evidence, the administrative record, the staff report, oral testimony, and other evidence presented, the Board of Supervisors finds and decides as follows:

#### **RECITALS**

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) requires that a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan be adopted for every project approved subject to mitigation measures (Public Resources Code Section 21081.6); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act Guidelines (CEQA Guidelines) were adopted by the State of California to provide administrative procedures to implement CEQA (Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the CEQA Guidelines, in Section 15097, provide guidelines to implement the statute requirement to adopt a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan for every project approved subject to mitigation measures; and

WHEREAS, the County of Monterey has adopted local guidelines for implementing the California Environmental Quality Act by Ordinance of the Board of Supervisors (Ordinance No. 04087) (Monterey County CEQA Guidelines); and

WHEREAS, the Monterey County CEQA Guidelines incorporate the same provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act that require adoption of a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Plan; and

WHEREAS, in response to a Settlement Agreement between Save Our Peninsula Committee and the County of Monterey in 2000, the Board of Supervisors adopted procedures for a County of Monterey Condition of Approval and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (Procedures); and

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2012, in response to further litigation from Save Our Peninsula Committee, the County amended the Procedures by Board of Supervisors Resolution No. 12-021 (Amended Procedures), including the requirement to prepare annual reports relating to the status of compliance with mitigation measures, any related code enforcement actions, and any proposed action to modify conditions of approval for land use projects approved in 2012 and 2013; and

WHEREAS, Section III.E of the Amended Procedures require that the annual reports be considered by the Board of Supervisors at a noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS, public notice of a March 11, 2014 public hearing at the Board of Supervisors, as required by the Amended Procedures, was published in the Monterey County Weekly on February 27, 2014; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with Section 9 of the Settlement Agreement (dated September 16, 2011), Save Our Peninsula Committee's representative was provided notice of the Monterey County Board of Supervisors public hearing noticed for March 11, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Save Our Peninsula Committee's representative requested that the hearing be continued to March 25, 2014 due to his unavailability on March 11, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors, on March 11, 2014, held a public hearing and continued the hearing to March 25, 2014 at the request of Save Our Peninsula Committee's representative; and

WHEREAS, County staff provided a staff report on March 25, 2014, for public and Board of Supervisors consideration, that provided annual reports for years 2012 and 2013, as required by the Amended Procedures; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors considered the 2012 and 2013 Annual Reports at its meeting on March 25, 2014 and took public testimony.

#### **DECISION**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Monterey County Board of Supervisors accepts the 2012 Annual Report for County of Monterey Condition of Approval and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and the 2013 Annual Report for County of Monterey Condition of Approval and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program, both hereby attached.
