WHEREAS, the Salinas Valley Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency ("SVBGSA") was formed though the creation of a Joint Powers Authority pursuant to the provisions of the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act ("SGMA"), codified in the California Water Code; and

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10730 permits a Groundwater Sustainability Agency to charge a regulatory fee for the funding of various regulatory activities, including the preparation of Groundwater Sustainability Plans; and,

WHEREAS, Water Code section 10730 (d) permits, as an alternative method of collection of such regulatory fee, the SVBGSA to adopt a resolution requesting that the Monterey County Auditor — Controller collect the fee in the same manner as ordinary municipal ad valorem taxes; and

WHEREAS, the SVBGSA adopted a regulatory fee ("Fee") pursuant to Water Code section 10730 on March 14, 2019, pursuant to its Resolution No. 2019-3; and,

WHEREAS, the Monterey County Auditor – Controller has requested specific certification regarding the compliance with state law for the charging and collection of the Fee, and

WHEREAS, the SVBGSA hereby requests that the Monterey County Auditor-Controller enter those fees identified in Exhibit "A" on the tax roll for collection and distribution by the Monterey County Treasurer – Tax Collector commencing with the property tax bills for fiscal year 2019-20; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors of the Salinas Valley Basin Groundwater Sustainability Agency as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct.
- 2. The SVBGSA hereby certifies that it has, without limitation, complied with all legal procedures and requirements necessary for the imposition of the fees identified in Exhibit "A", regardless of whether those procedures and requirements are set forth in the Constitution of the State of California, in State statutes, or in the applicable decisional law of the State of California.

3. The SVBGSA further certifies that, except for the sole negligence or misconduct of the County of Monterey, its officers, employees, and agents, with regards to the handling of the CD or electronic file identified as Exhibit "A", the SVBGSA shall be solely liable and responsible for defending, at its sole expense, cost, and risk, each and every action, suit, or other proceeding brought against the County of Monterey, its officers, employees, and agents for every claim, demand, or challenge to the imposition of the fees identified in Exhibit "A" and that it shall pay or satisfy any judgment rendered against the County of Monterey, its officers, employees, and agents on every such action, suit, or other proceeding, including all claims for refunds and interest thereon, legal fees and court costs, and administrative expenses of the County of Monterey to correct the tax rolls.
