MRWPCA Focused Wastewater Service Area Study Scope:

- Update and finalize Focused Wastewater Service Area Study – Update should include latest flow and compliance data for existing small facilities, update housing and growth projections, validate methodologies used to establish potential capacity needs for each area, update potential capacity needed and conceptual infrastructure needs for each area based on latest data and information.

\$40,000

- Evaluate the potential to include additional areas for consolidation into the MRWPCA service area, i.e., Prundale, Chualar, San Jerardo, etc. Study any additional areas to be included for potential capacity and infrastructure needs.

\$25,000

- Develop Basis for Design (10% design) for infrastructure necessary to service the Toro Area.

\$40,000

- Identify potential grant opportunities to fund infrastructure necessary to provide service to additional areas, specifically the Toro Area and assist with grant application as needed.

\$4,000

- Assist with developing information and materials MRWPCA may need to provide LAFCO for Municipal Service Review (MSR) or annexation/sphere of influence expansion for additional service areas – possibly GIS mapping, legal descriptions, etc.

\$6,000

- Technical support for CEQA specifically for inclusion of Toro area into MRWPCA and construction of required infrastructure. Also possible CEQA support that may be needed for larger LAFCO MSR and MRWPCA service area annexation.

\$10,000
