

**AMENDMENT NO. 2  
TO SERVICES AGREEMENT  
BETWEEN NATIVIDAD MEDICAL FOUNDATION AND  
NATIVIDAD MEDICAL CENTER  
FOR  
PHILANTHROPIC AND OTHER SPECIALTY SERVICES**

This Amendment No. 2 to the Services Agreement (“Agreement”) which was effective on January 1, 2015 is entered into by and between the County of Monterey (hereinafter “COUNTY”), on behalf of Natividad Medical Center (hereinafter “NMC”), and **Natividad Medical Foundation** (hereinafter “CONTRACTOR”). Collectively, COUNTY, NMC and CONTRACTOR are referred to as the “Parties”, with respect to the following:

**RECITALS**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Monterey on behalf of Natividad Medical Center and Natividad Medical Foundation entered into an Agreement for philanthropic and other specialty services with a term January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 and a total Agreement amount not to exceed \$876,019; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties amended the Agreement on January 13, 2016 via Amendment No. 1 to extend the term for an additional two year period through December 31, 2017 and to add additional services to the scope of services as per “Exhibit A-1 per Amendment No. 1” attached to Amendment No. 1 with an increase of \$1,818,555, thereby increasing the total Agreement amount to \$2,694,574; and

**WHEREAS**, the Parties currently wish to amend the Agreement to extend it for an additional two (2) year period through December 31, 2019 to allow for services to continue with additions to the scope of services attached hereto this Amendment No. 2 as “Exhibit A-2 per Amendment No. 2” with an increase of \$1,915,370 for the added services for a revised total Agreement amount not to exceed \$4,609,944.

**AGREEMENT**

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the Parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

The Agreement is hereby renewed on the terms and conditions as set forth in the original Agreement and in Amendment No 1 and in Amendment No. 2 incorporated herein by this reference, except as specifically set forth below.

1. **Section 2 / Paragraph titled, “PAYMENTS BY NMC” shall be amended by removing:**

“NMC shall pay the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the payment provisions set forth in Exhibit A plus Exhibit A-1 as per Amendment No. 1 attached hereto this Amendment No. 1. The total amount payable by NMC to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of \$2,694,574.”

**and replacing it with:**

“NMC shall pay the CONTRACTOR in accordance with the payment provisions set forth in Exhibit A plus Exhibit A-1 and Exhibit A-2 as per Amendment No. 2 attached hereto this Amendment No. 2, subject to the limitations set forth in this Agreement. The total amount payable by NMC to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement shall not exceed the sum of \$4,609,944.”

2. **The first sentence of Section 3.1/Paragraph titled, "TERM OF AGREEMENT" shall be amended by removing:**

"The term of this Agreement is from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017 unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement."

**and replacing it with:**

"The term of this Agreement is from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2019 unless sooner terminated pursuant to the terms of this Agreement."

3. **Section 4/ Paragraph titled, "ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS/EXHIBITS" shall be amended by removing the following:**

"The following attached exhibits are incorporated herein by reference and constitute a part of this Agreement:

Exhibit A: Scope of Services/Payment Provisions

Exhibit A-1 as per Amendment No. 1: Revised Scope of Services/Payment Provisions."

**and replacing it with:**

"The following attached exhibits are incorporated herein by reference and constitute a part of this Agreement:

Exhibit A-1: Revised Scope of Services/Payment Provisions as per Amendment No. 1

Exhibit A-2: Revised Scope of Services/Payment Provisions as per Amendment No. 2"

4. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions and provisions of the original Agreement are unchanged and unaffected by this Amendment No. 2 and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the original Agreement and in Amendment No. 1 and Amendment No. 2.
5. A copy of this Amendment No. 2 shall be attached to the original Agreement.
6. This Amendment No. 2 shall be effective when signed by both Parties.

**Revised Scope of Services/Payment Provisions**

**I. Description of All Services to be Rendered by CONTRACTOR:**

Natividad Medical Foundation (NMF), established by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors in 1988, is dedicated to philanthropically supporting Natividad Medical Center (NMC) in its mission to continually monitor and improve the health status of the people of Monterey County, including the vulnerable, through access to high quality, coordinated health care services, regardless of ability to pay.

Natividad Medical Foundation assists NMC with specially requested services and provides philanthropic services in support of NMC’s Strategic Plan, defined as:

- Major gift planning and fundraising;
- Community outreach in connection with fundraising;
- Preparing and submitting foundation and government grant applications;
- Administering current/future foundation grants;
- Supporting interpreting services; and
- Supporting and coordinating NMC/NMF joint community relations.

Natividad Medical Center’s CEO serves as an ex officio voting member of Natividad Medical Foundation’s Board of Directors as the primary mechanism for ensuring continuous communication between the hospital and the Foundation regarding NMF’s initiatives and fundraising progress. NMF’s President & CEO regularly participates in meetings of the hospital’s Board of Trustees, and, on occasion, provides educational presentations to inform the Board of the Foundation’s work.

Services are delivered at Natividad Medical Center, 1441 Constitution Blvd., Salinas, CA 93906. Some grant-funded program services and community relations activities are delivered and conducted at various community sites throughout Monterey County.

**II. CONTRACTOR Obligations:**

In 2018 and 2019, Natividad Medical Foundation will achieve the following goals and deliverables:

**III. Pricing/Fees:**

The total maximum liability for 2018 and 2019 under this agreement is \$1,915,370. This total covers the Foundation operating costs; 1.) NMF Salaries, Wages, Benefits Operating Support; 2.) Physician - Medical Director of Health Promotion & Education; and 3.) Joint NMC/NMF Community Relations. CONTRACTOR shall invoice NMC on a quarterly basis.

Sales tax and travel fees are not applicable under this agreement.
