Dear Ms. Israel,

This letter is to follow up on our conversations after the LUAC meeting. We met with architects and engineers to explore options for creating a walking trail easement along the southern portion of our property.

Unfortunately, the trail is not possible for a number of reasons. First, the trail would be located on a slope in excess of 25% grade which would create a potential hazard to anyone traveling over a trail. Second, the trail would pass next to or over an environmentally protected native habitat area that cannot be disturbed. Third, the trail would run across our property and empty behind our neighbor's property on the banks of the Carmel River and into more protected native habitat area. During the heavy 2023 rains, the river came up to and over portions of the area where the trail would be located behind our neighbor's property. Fourth, after the trail crosses our neighbor's property, the trail would empty onto Robinson Canyon Road where there are no sidewalks.

Even if we changed the footprint of our buildings to accommodate a walking trail, there is no way to avoid emptying the trail into the environmentally sensitive habitat areas of the Carmel River and its bank and flood plain. The Carmel River is a protected wetland where steelhead trout run.

We will revise our elevations to reflect proposed changes to the building facades, materials, and colors, but we would like to proceed with our project design submitted that was deemed complete.

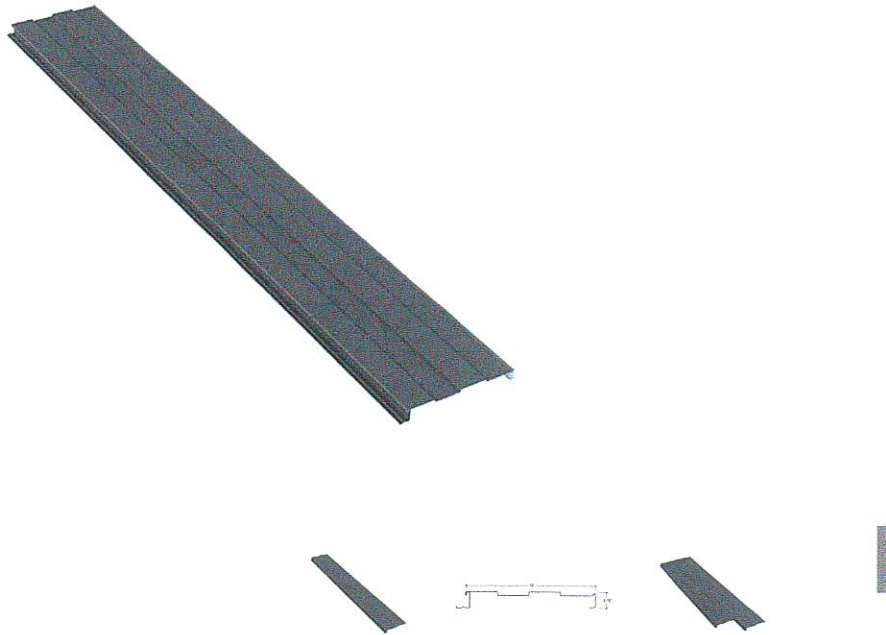
