**AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF MONTEREY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTION 12.24.010 OF THE MONTEREY COUNTY CODE RELATING
TO THROUGH HIGHWAYS**

County Counsel Summary

This ordinance amends section 12.24.010 of the Monterey County Code to rescind the designation of the following roads as through highways: Barloy Canyon Road from Watkins Gate Road generally southeast to its terminus; Watkins Gate Road from West Camp Street generally northeast to its terminus; and West Camp Street from Sherman Boulevard generally southeast to its terminus. This action corrects the previous action by the Board of Supervisors which designated these segments as through highways in error. These roads are in the East Garrison area of the unincorporated area of the County of Monterey.

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND FINDINGS. Pursuant to Article XI, section 7 of the California Constitution, the County of Monterey may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations not in conflict with general laws to protect and promote the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens. California Vehicle Code Section 21354 authorizes the County of Monterey to designate any highway under its jurisdiction as a through highway and to erect stop signs at entrances thereto or to designate any intersection under its exclusive jurisdiction as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one or more entrances thereto. This action corrects the previous action by the Board of Supervisors which designated these segments as through highways in error. These roads are not currently part of the County-maintained road system.

SECTION 2. Section 12.24.010 of the Monterey County Code is amended by deleting from that section the following paragraphs:

Barloy Canyon Road, from Watkins Gate Road generally southeast to its terminus;

Watkins Gate Road, from West Camp Street generally northeast to its terminus;

West Camp Street, from Sherman Boulevard generally southeast to its terminus;

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall become effective on the thirty-first day following its adoption.


