## AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN COUNTY OF MONTEREY AND THE SOCIAL CHANGERY, LLC

**THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1** to the Agreement is made by and between the County of Monterey, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and The Social Changery, LLC. (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR") with respect to the following.

**WHEREAS,** on November 17, 2023, County and CONTRACTOR entered into Agreement in the amount of \$70,000 for the term November 17, 2023, through June 30, 2024, for the provision social media messaging and educational games that empower youth to make informed decisions for their health and increase critical thinking skills; and

**WHEREAS** the County and CONTRACTOR wish to amend the AGREEMENT to revise EXHIBIT A: SCOPE OF SERVICES/PAYMENT PROVISIONS to reflect an increase of \$99,750 to the budget as agreed to by both parties for a revised total AGREEMENT in the amount of \$169,750;

**NOW THEREFORE**, County and CONTRACTOR hereby agree to amend the Agreement in the following manner:

- 1. **Paragraph 2, "Payment Provisions", shall be amended by removing** "The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement is not to exceed the sum of **\$70,000**." **and replacing it with** "The total amount payable by County to CONTRACTOR under this Agreement is not to exceed the sum of **\$169,750**.".
- 2. **EXHIBIT A-1: SCOPE OF SERVICES/PAYMENT PROVISIONS replaces EXHIBIT A:** SCOPE OF SERVICES/PAYMENT PROVISIONS. All references in the AGREEMENT to EXHIBIT A shall be construed to refer to EXHIBIT A-1.
- 3. Except as provided herein, all remaining terms, conditions, and provisions of the Agreement are unchanged and unaffected by this Amendment No. 1 and shall continue in full force and effect as set forth in the Agreement.
- 4. A copy of this Amendment No. 1 shall be attached to the original Agreement executed by County on November 17, 2023.

# **Scope of Services / Payment Provisions**

### A. SCOPE OF SERVICES

A.1 CONTRACTOR shall provide services and staff, and otherwise do all things necessary for or incidental to the performance of work, as set forth below:

The Social Changery, LLC will assist the County of Monterey's Cannabis Education Program to expand existing [Cannabis] Decoded social media messaging that empowers and supports local high school youth to make informed decisions for their health and futures. In addition, the Social Changery will provide 250 educational escape game packets that will be distributed to local high schools to engage Monterey County youth and young adults. The [Cannabis] Decoded game aims to provide youth with critical thinking and decision-making skills to resist peer pressure and delay the initiation of cannabis use.

A.2 The Social Changery will create media assets and collateral material with driving under the influence (DUI) messaging that align with the grant from the Office of Traffic Safety to encourage people who use cannabis to avoid driving.

#### **B. PAYMENT PROVISIONS**

#### **B.1 COMPENSATION/ PAYMENT**

County shall pay an amount not to exceed \$169,750 for the performance of <u>all things</u> <u>necessary</u> for or incidental to the performance of work as set forth in the Scope of Work. CONTRACTOR'S compensation for services rendered shall be based on the following rates or in accordance with the following terms:

# **B.2 CONTRACTORS BILLING PROCEDURES**

No payments in advance or in anticipation of services or supplies to be provided under this Agreement shall be made by County.

County shall not pay any claims for payment for services submitted more than twelve (12) months after the calendar month in which the services were completed.

DISALLOWED COSTS: CONTRACTOR is responsible for any audit exceptions or disallowed costs incurred by its own organization or that of its subcontractors.

- e. Itemize costs for the billing period in the same detail as indicated in the scope. of services in the agreement. Reimbursement may only be sought for those costs and/or cost categories expressly identified as allowable in this agreement and approved by the County of Monterey.
