- a. If legally feasible, allow for any additional funds to be used to follow through on commitments that were made to the community, specifically, in the legal documents when the mine was permitted.
- b. Determine that the Carmel Stone Mine is abandoned by the Operator;
- c. Authorize the Housing and Community Development (HCD) Director or his designee to seize the Financial Assurance Mechanism (FAM) put in place for the Carmel Stone Mine (PLN090191) California Mine ID# 91-27-0030 and reclaim the mine site;
- d. Authorize the HCD Director or his designee to proceed with all tasks necessary to complete reclamation of the Carmel Stone Mine.
