Adopt a resolution of appreciation of California State Senator Anna Caballero for )  
her outstanding representation and advocacy on behalf of the County of Monterey. )

WHEREAS, Senator Caballero has served with excellence and distinction as California State Senator of the 14<sup>th</sup> District, which includes the County of Monterey, since first being elected in December 2018 and again for a second term in 2022, and

WHEREAS, Senator Caballero's leadership representing the County of Monterey has been exemplary as she has demonstrated a remarkable ability to build relationships with the Board of Supervisors and County residents through her genuine concern for the County's unique objectives and requests, and

WHEREAS, Senator Caballero worked on the creation of the California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant Program through the passage of SB 87 which provided over 1,700 awards totaling over \$20.6 million to local businesses, and

WHEREAS, In 2023, Senator Caballero worked to secure \$20 million for the County of Monterey for flood recovery efforts in Pajaro following devastating flooding, and

WHEREAS, In 2023, through SB 800, Senator Caballero played a pivotal role in partnering with Monterey County and the City of Marina to facilitate the expansion of Joby Aviation's manufacturing facility, and

WHEREAS, In 2023, Senator Caballero authored SB 831 which assists local agricultural workers seeking permanent residency, and

WHEREAS, Senator Caballero worked to secure direct legislative appropriations that have been awarded to the Monterey County region including, but not limited to: \$5 million for the Salinas Regional Soccer Complex; \$5 million for the Teen Innovation Center in Gonzales; \$1.25 million for a Quint aerial apparatus and security camera system in King City; \$2 million for a fire truck in Soledad; \$1.8 million for community park and communication projects in the rural, agricultural portion of the Salinas Valley; \$1 million for radio transmission and reception improvements in Greenfield; \$400,000 for improvements at Soledad Mission Recreation District; \$400,000 for Park Recreation Center facility upgrades in King City; and

WHEREAS, After six years as State Senator representing the people of Monterey County and the State of California, District 14 has been redistricted and therefore, County of Monterey will not fall within the 14<sup>th</sup> District after the November 2024 elections.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors, on behalf of the County and all its residents, therefore, hereby recognize and thank California State Senator Anna Caballero for her many years of outstanding public service which has directly improved the lives of the people of Monterey County and the State of California.
