**WHEREAS**, **Safe Ag Safe Schools Coalition** is being honored by the Nonprofit Alliance of Monterey County as the Award Recipient for Outstanding Community Engagement 2024, and

**WHEREAS**, **Safe Ag Safe Schools Coalition** is a coalition of 50-plus organizations and individuals working together to reduce pesticide exposure threats to Monterey Bay residents and keep school children safe from hazardous pesticides that cause harms such as asthma and developmental delays, and

**WHEREAS**, **Safe Ag Safe Schools Coalition** is mobilizing Monterey County and Santa Cruz County by lobbying Sacramento Legislators and local Ag Commissioners to be more responsive on providing notification on pesticide use, and

**WHEREAS**, **Safe Ag Safe Schools Coalition** is following the legacy of Cesar Chavez – with their vision of protecting farmworkers and their families from the dangers of pesticide exposure, and

**WHEREAS**, **Safe Ag Safe Schools Coalition** has been able to ban round up use in local school districts, creating a ¼ mile pesticide-free buffer zone around all California schools Monday through Friday (6 am to 6 pm),
