Monterey County Department of Social Services (MCDSS) is pleased to inform you that \$350,000 of the Monterey County Housing Assistance and Prevention Program, round 3 allocation (HHAP-3) has been endorsed by the Monterey County Board of Supervisors to support your Homekey project application. HHAP-3 was created by Govern Newson and is administered through the Business Consumer Services and Housing Agency under the Homeless Coordinating and Financing Council (HCFC).

The main purpose of these funds is to provide support for regional collaboration and to expand or develop local capacity to address our immediate homelessness challenges. The Monterey County Board of Supervisors believes that the development of these permanent housing units will help us increase capacity within Monterey County to better understand and serve our most vulnerable population.
