WHEREAS, Alfredo Esparza has distinguished himself as a dependable and loyal employee and a versatile and self-motivated officer, capable to shift priorities as needed and meet the multiple interruptions and demands common to institutions and calmly managing stressful situations; and

WHEREAS, Alfredo Esparza has willingly lent his videographer skills and expertise to create a bilingual orientation to inform for youth entering Juvenile Hall; and

WHEREAS, Alfredo Esparza has chosen to retire from the Monterey County Probation Department after twenty-one years of dedicated County service, effective December 24, 2017, and as he enters a new stage in his life, those who have been fortunate in working with him will remember his dedication to the Probation Department, his superiors, colleagues and subordinates, and to the youth, families, and citizens of Monterey County.
