Approve and authorize the Director of Health Services or designee to execute a Renewal and Amendment No. 1 to Mental Health Services Agreement A-15923 with Centro Binacional para el Desarrollo Indígena Oaxaqueño (CBDIO), retroactive to July 1, 2023, to add community event services for the same total Agreement amount not to exceed \$500,000, and same term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024.

### RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors:

Approve and authorize the Director of Health Services or designee to execute a Renewal and Amendment No. 1 to Mental Health Services Agreement A-15923 with Centro Binacional para el Desarrollo Indígena Oaxaqueño (CBDIO), retroactive to July 1, 2023, to add community event services for the same total Agreement amount not to exceed \$500,000, and same term of July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2024.

### SUMMARY/DISCUSSION

Centro Binacional para el Desarrollo Indígena Oaxaqueño (CBDIO) is a community-based agency that provides Maternal Mental Health Prevention and Early Intervention program services to prevent Perinatal Mood and Anxiety Disorder (PMAD) from developing, and if present, provide effective treatment. CBIDO specifically targets the Indigenous community in Greenfield and King City who are at higher risk for PMAD. CBDIO programs focus on working with Indigenous families providing orientations, trainings, counseling, and referrals that are culturally relevant.

The Renewal and Amendment No. 1 adds community events supporting Maternal Mental Health Prevention and Early Intervention to FY 2023-2024 and replaces Exhibit F: Business Associate Agreement with the January 2024 Board approved Business Associate Agreement version. This Renewal and Amendment No. 1 is retroactive to July 1, 2023, due to delay in receiving the cyber liability as required by Exhibit F: Business Associate Agreement.

This work supports the County of Monterey Health Department 2018-2024 Strategic Plan Goal(s): 3. Ensure access to culturally and linguistically appropriate, customer-friendly, quality health services. It also supports one of the ten essential public health services, specifically: 7. Link people to needed personal health services and assure the provisions of health care when otherwise unavailable.

### OTHER AGENCY INVOLVEMENT:

The office of the County Counsel and Auditor-Controller have reviewed and approved as to legal

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form and fiscal provisions, respectively.

FINANCING:

This Agreement is funded by Mental Health Services Act Prevention and Early Intervention (MHSA PEI) revenues (100%). The funds for this Agreement are included in the Health Department's Behavioral Health (HEA012, Unit 8410) Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23 and FY 2023-2024 Adopted Budgets.
