The questions received to date are the following, along with their respective responses:

Question 1: Our understanding is the inventory is for warning and regulatory signs only, and therefore would exclude street name signs, parking control signs, G signs, paddle markers, and object markers. Please confirm.

<u>Answer 1:</u> Yes, as included in the scope, the project is to inventory warning and regulatory signs for the list of County roads stated in the RFP.

Question 2: Approximately how many signs are in the existing County sign inventory, and approximately how many are under this project (that is, regulatory and warning signs)?

<u>Answer 2:</u> The County has approximately 15,000 traffic signs throughout the county. This project will establish an inventory of warning and regulatory signs for the County roads stated in the RFP.

Question 3: There seems to be no accepted, quantitative standard for sign reflectivity. We may propose to measure this subjectively by night visual observation. If so, will that be acceptable?

<u>Answer 3:</u> Nighttime visual inspection by a trained sign inspector is allowed. Although allowed, it is desirable that the minimum retroreflectivity level be per Table 2A-3 of the CA MUTCD 2014.

Question 4: Is there a roadway striping inventory, as well as signage?

<u>Answer 4:</u> The County does not have an existing striping inventory. This project will establish a striping inventory for the County roads stated in the RFP.
