a. Received an update in response to Board Referral No. 2023.20, submitted by Board of Supervisor Church, addressing littering fines for illegal dumping and littering of solid waste and refuse; and

b. Directed staff as follows:


The task force shall continue to evaluate and refine the camera program. Further brainstorming is required to find the most effective solutions for tackling illegal dumping in high-risk areas. The community's involvement and feedback are seen as essential in refining the program going forward. The next steps involve adjusting strategies for camera placement, public education, and considering alternative enforcement methods such as community service. The Monterey County Connect app will help citizens report dumping more easily.
