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Upon motion of Supervisor Salinas, seconded by Supervisor Calcagno and carried by those members present, the Board of Supervisors hereby:

- a. Received a report from Resource Management Agency-Planning regarding the three possible appropriate authority processing options for lot line adjustment and minor subdivision applications related to the proposed elimination of the County's Minor and Standard Subdivision Committees;
- b. Approved *Option 3* which would result in the Director of Planning acting as the appropriate authority over non-controversial inland lot line adjustment and minor subdivision applications, while the Planning Commission would be the appropriate authority over controversial inland lot line adjustment and minor subdivision applications and all coastal lot line adjustment and minor subdivision applications; and
