# Monterey County Board of Supervisors Tobacco Retail Ordinance Amendment

January 25, 2022



#### **Current Draft Amendment**

- Bans retailers from selling flavored tobacco products in unincorporated Monterey County
- ► Bans retailers from selling single-use ecigarettes in unincorporated Monterey County and creates an exception to any FDA approved aide or device for smoking cessation

## What Would be Permitted Pursuant to Current Proposed Draft?

- ► Retail sale of any refillable e-cigarette
- Any single use e-cigarette that is an FDA approved device or aide for smoking cessation

### FDA Approval vs. Authorization

- No e-cigarette is currently <u>approved</u> by the FDA as a smoking cessation aide
- ► However, in October of 2021, the FDA <u>authorized</u> the marketing of Vuse Solo closed system e-cigarette and tobacco flavored cartridges

### **Current Administrative Fines for Violations of the TRL Ordinance**

- First offense, \$1,000
- ► Second offense, \$5,000
