AT RISK

- ► The annual assessment roll becomes the base upon which local property taxes are levied, collected and subsequently distributed to the cities, County, and special districts to fund government services.
 - Delayed property reassessment and value enrollment
 - ▶ Less Property taxes levied, less collected and apportioned to the cities, counties, schools, and special district
 - ▶ <u>60-70% of the County's discretionary funds will be lower</u>
 - ► Less dollars to the GFC used to fund salaries and benefits and core services of departments
 - ► Customer service timely impact
 - Frustrated/angry property owners
 - ▶ Untimely valuation

IMPACT TO THE DEPARTMENT AND THE COUNTY

- ▶ 4,789 Remaining supplemental assessments
 - ► Tentative revenue \$1.7B
 - ► Average supplemental = \$355k
- Reduced staff to process reappraisal events
 - Increased workloads for staff
 - Lower enrolled dollars to all the agencies that depend on property tax levied and collected

IF WE DON'T HAVE A FULL STAFF, WE CAN'T ENROLL THE REAPPRIASAL EVENT TIMELY, AND THE COUNTY DOESN'T GET THE REVENUE FROM THESE EVENTS TO FUND CORE SERVICES
