Reservoir Storage & Release Update

SUMMARY/DISCUSSION:

The Board of Directors receives monthly updates on the status of Agency reservoirs.

RESERVOIR ELEVATION / STORAGE: As of August 20, 2025, San Antonio Reservoir has a water surface elevation of approximately 749.35 feet (NGVD 29), with 193,945 acre-feet of water in storage. Nacimiento Reservoir has a water surface elevation of approximately 753.35 feet, with 162,564 acre-feet of water in storage. San Antonio Reservoir is currently at 58% of storage capacity and Nacimiento Reservoir is at 43% of capacity.

RAINFALL: There has been no recent precipitation and there is currently no inflow to the reservoirs.

SALINAS RIVER LAGOON: The lagoon has been closed to the ocean since May 16, 2025.

RESERVOIR RELEASES: Releases are being made from both reservoirs for beneficial uses including groundwater recharge, operation of the Salinas River Diversion Facility, and to provide for required bypass flow to the Salinas Lagoon. Target releases as of August 20, 2025:

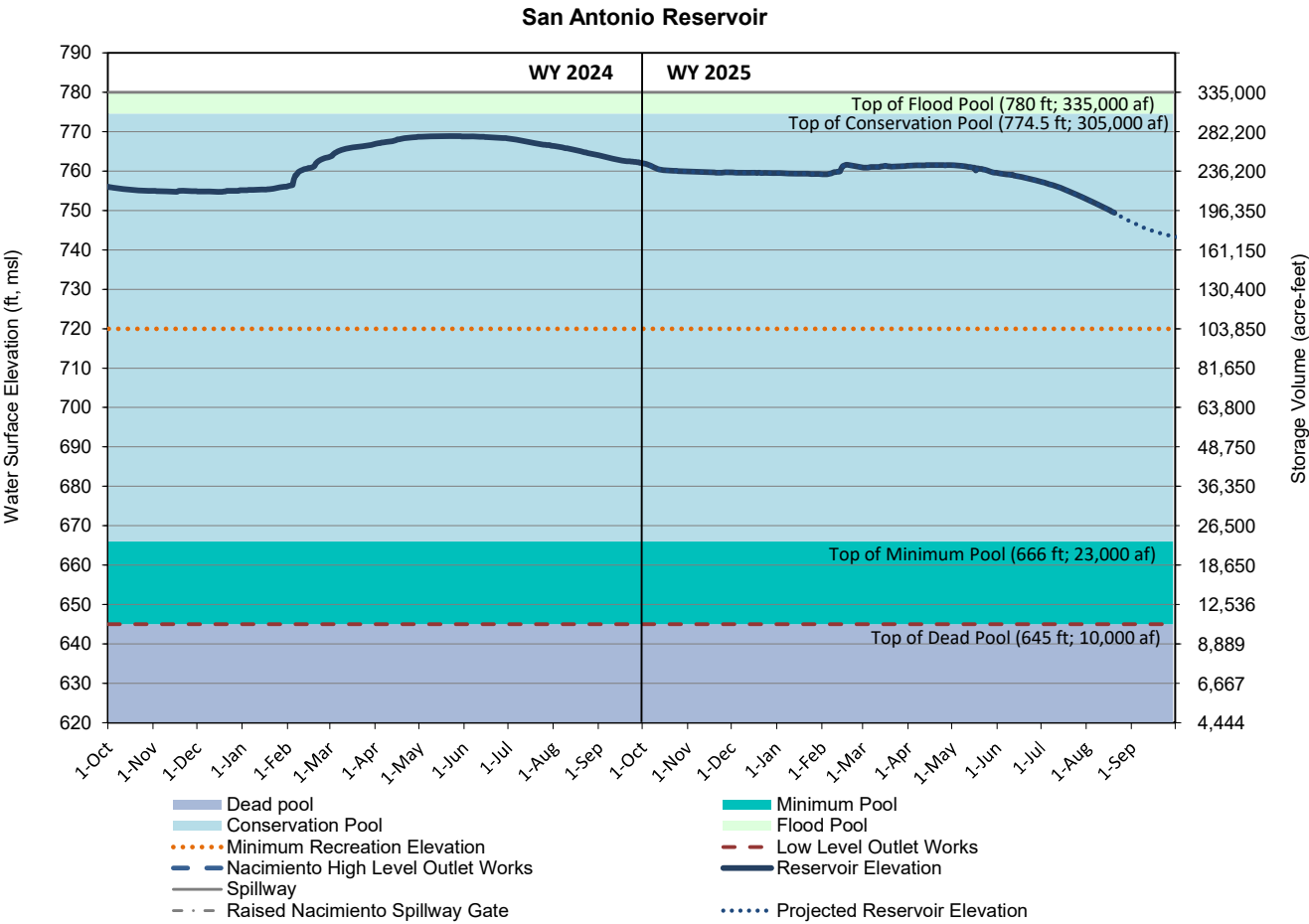
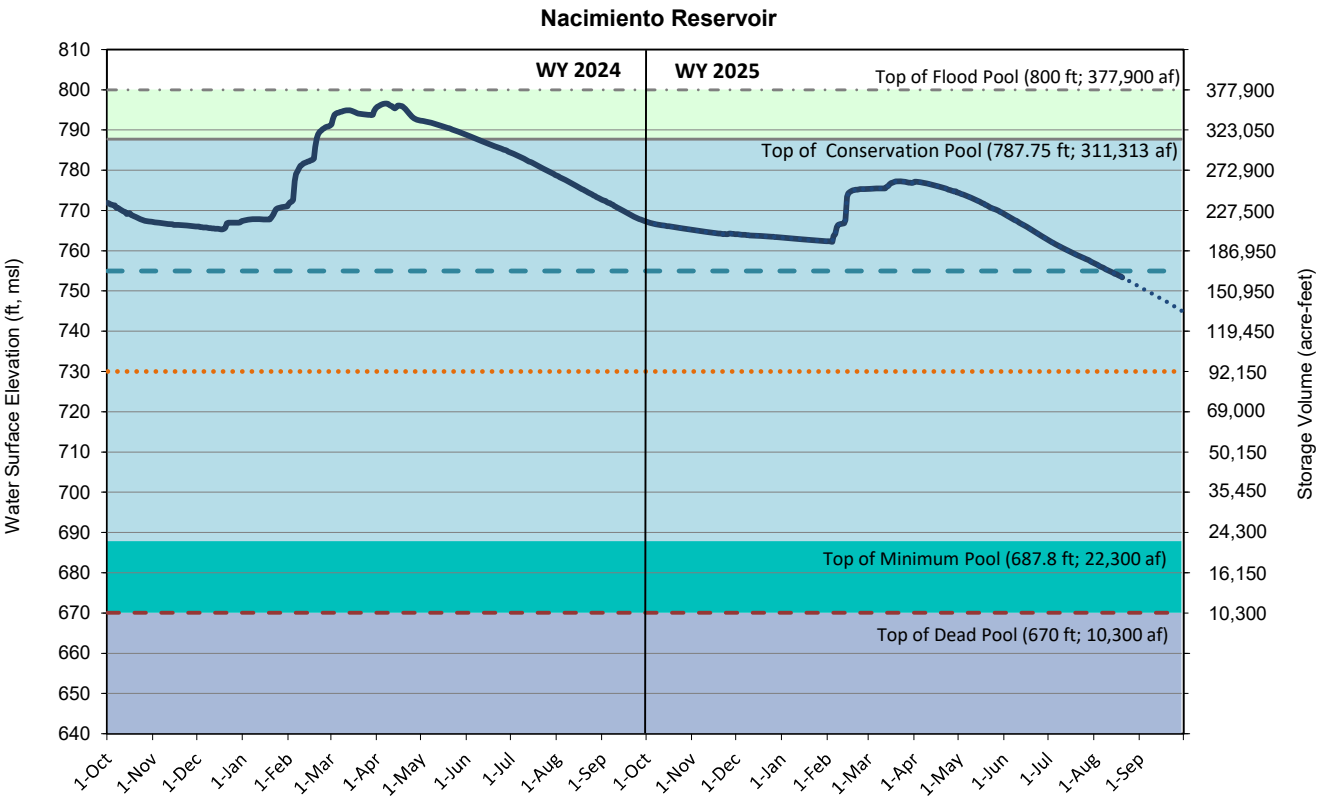
- Nacimiento Reservoir: 280 cfs
- San Antonio Reservoir: 375 cfs

Total target releases from both reservoirs to the Salinas River are approximately 655 cfs. The following “provisional” flows have been recorded by the USGS:

- Nacimiento River below Nacimiento Dam 273 cfs
- Salinas River near Bradley: 585 cfs
- Salinas River at Soledad: 268 cfs
- Salinas River near Chualar: 89 cfs
- Salinas River near Spreckels: 43 cfs

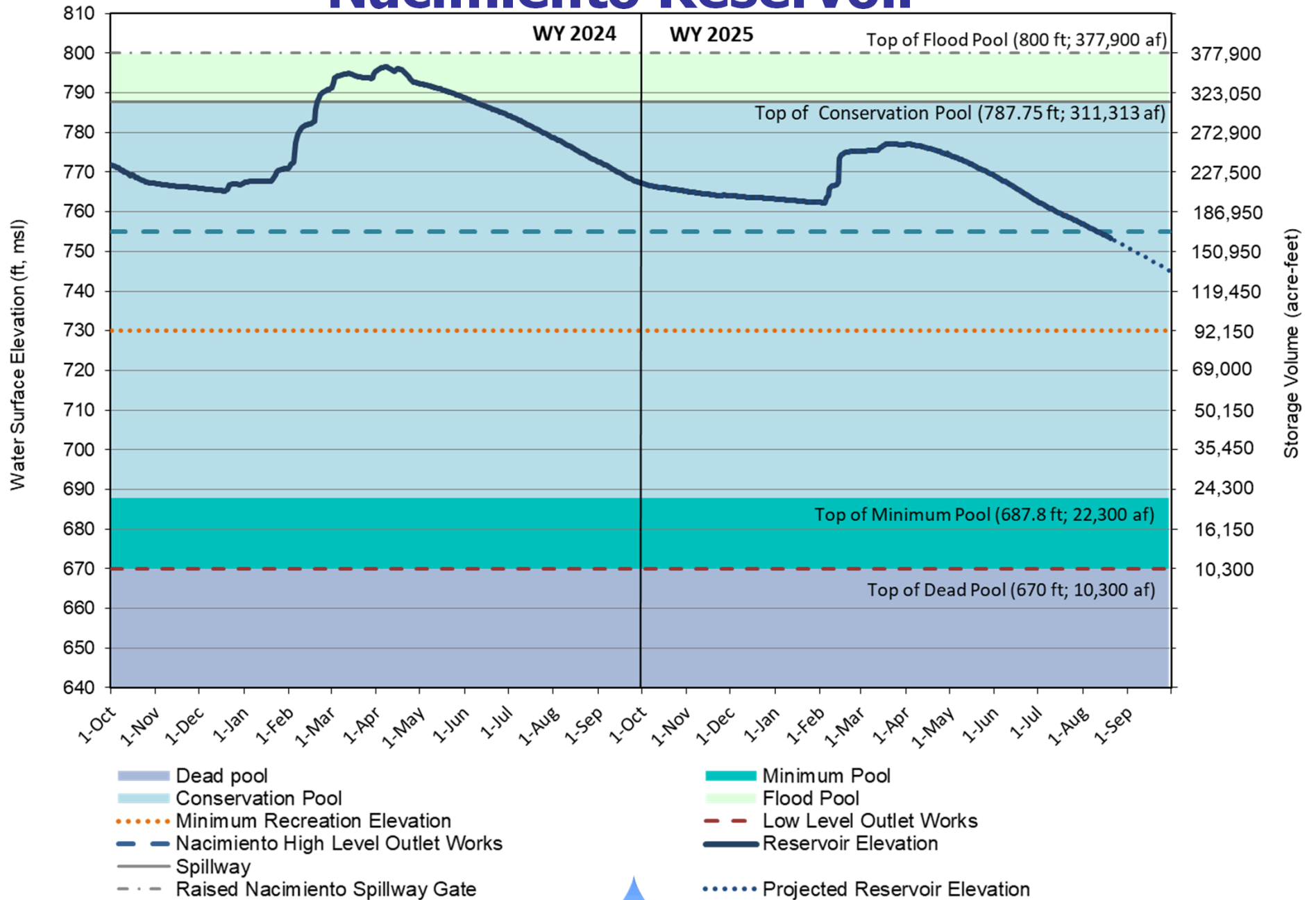

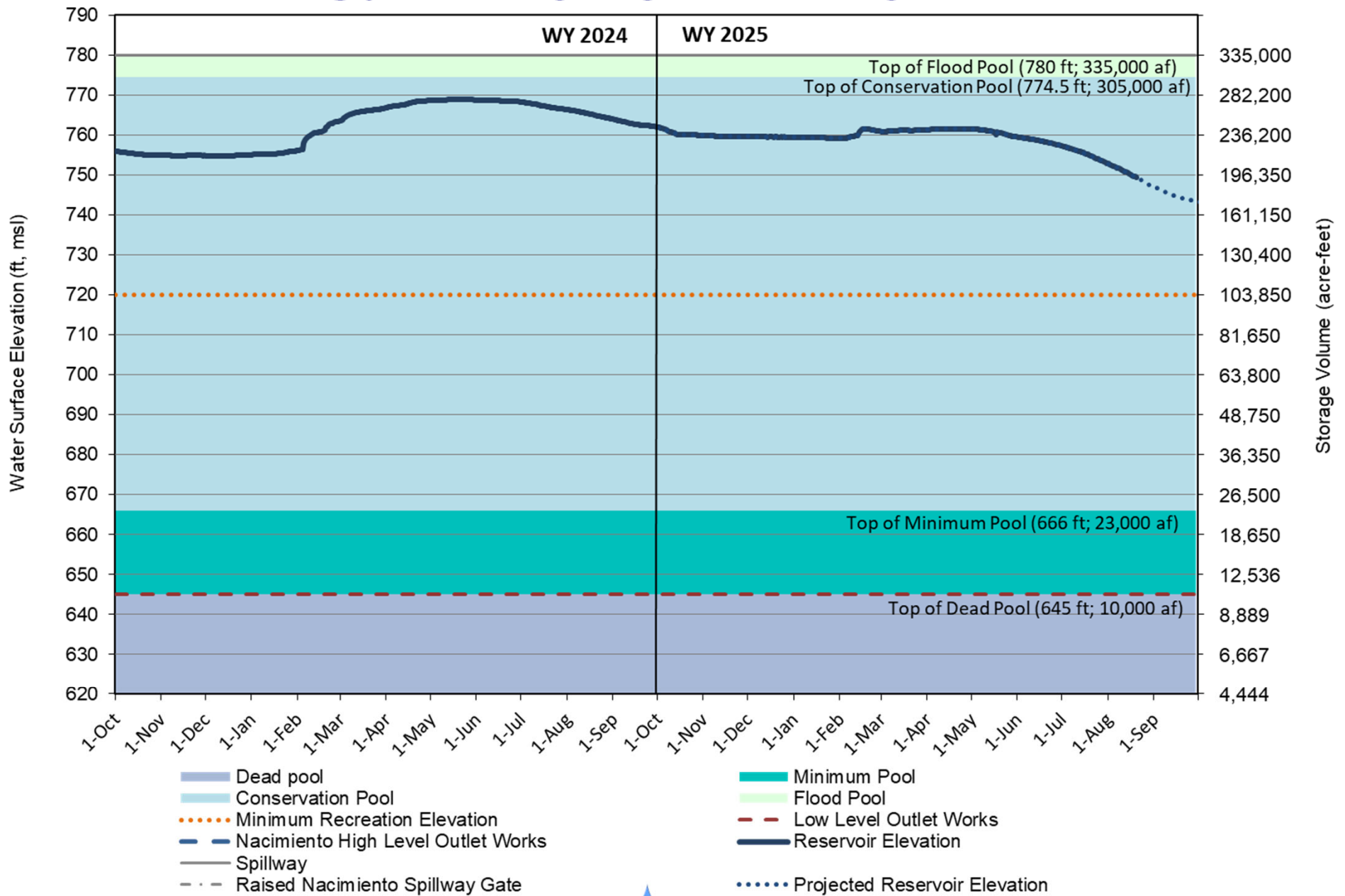

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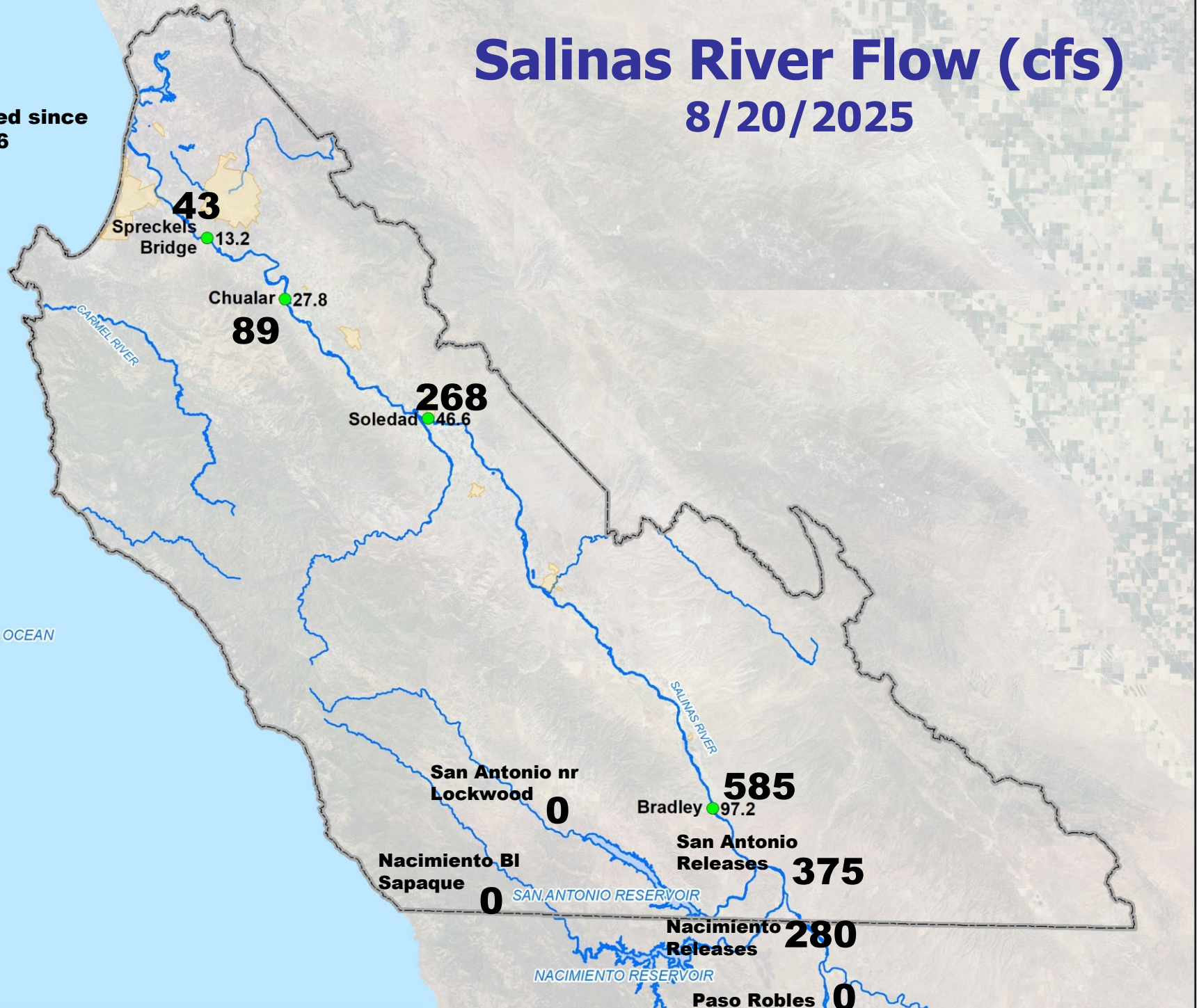


Salinas River Flow (cfs)

Bold text indicates actual values. The Reservoir Release Schedule includes estimated monthly release values to meet the goals of dam safety, flood protection, groundwater recharge, operation of the SRDF, water supply, fish migration, fish habitat requirements, agriculture, and recreation while complying with water rights, permits, and existing agreements. Salinas River conditions are dynamic, and the reservoir releases required to meet downstream goals can vary based on watershed and climatic conditions. The Release Schedule is updated throughout the year with actual releases and updated estimates to reflect these changing conditions.
