**WHEREAS**, to help reduce collisions, Caltrans and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife remind motorists to be on the lookout during **Watch Out for Wildlife Week**, held annually in the third week of September; and

**WHEREAS**, collisions with wildlife not only harm wildlife, but large animals can damage vehicles and cause injury and death to drivers and passengers.; and

**WHEREAS**, **Watch Out for Wildlife Week** coincides with the season when California’s wildlife migrate and look for mates, and California’s roadways often cut through these animals’ migration routes; and

**WHEREAS**, deer, bears and other wildlife are most likely to be killed or injured by vehicle collisions between September and December.; and

**WHEREAS**, it is vital that drivers be especially alert now through December to avoid collisions with wildlife;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Monterey County Board of Supervisors on behalf of the County and all citizens thereof, hereby declare the week of September 16, 2019 as **Watch Out for Wildlife Week** in Monterey County.
