


### Requested Action

 Adopt an ordinance amending Title 21 of the Monterey County Code to amend Chapter 21.08, Chapter 21.50, and Sections 1-108 of Section 21.08.060 of Title 21 of the Monterey County Code to reclassify multiple zoning districts for consistency with their 2010 County of Monterey General Plan land use designations



## **Project Scope**

- Update to Sectional District Maps
  - All Inland Area Zoning Map
- Amendments to Title 21
  - Corrections and Amendments to MCC Chapter 21.08; and
  - Amendment to MCC Chapter 21.50.





## Land Use Designation vs. Zoning

- Land Use Designation:
  - Is prescribed in the county's general plan land use element
  - Reflects the desired future development patterns for an area
  - Designates general locations and intensity for development, such as residential, commercial, industrial, and public uses

- Zoning:
  - Should implement the land use designations
  - Sets design and development requirements (standards)

## **Update to Sectional District Maps**



#### **Amendments to Title 21**

- Update Title 21:
  - Chapter 21.08 (Establishment and Designation of Zoning Districts)
    - MCC section 21.08.010 correction for Mixed Use Zoning District.
    - MCC section 21.08.030.C amendments to process for addressing the uncertainty of zoning district boundaries.
    - MCC section 21.08.030.D addition to clarify instances where there is an absence of zoning on a parcel.
    - MCC section 21.08.060 correction to incorporation of all Sectional District Maps.
  - Chapter 21.50 (Urban Reserve Zoning District)
    - MCC section 21.50.030.D addition to clarify regulations for development proposals for compliance with Board-adopted Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).
