#### I am a retired Fire Chlef/Fire Training Officer

In 1994 I was instrumental in organizing the "Ormsby Volunteer Fire Brigade" in the Santa Cruz Mountains. I helped establish the fire brigade as a nonprofit, and acquired funding from Santa Clara County to build a fire station on Summit Rd. in the year 2000. I was elected Fire Chief in 2000. I served until 2004. In 2006 I became the Training Officer to all the volunteer fire departments in Santa Clara County from 2004-2008. I taught CPR, First Responder, Wildland Suppression and Over the Side Rescue, to CAL FIRE and volunteers until the year 2008 when I retired.

I taught Fire Suppression at Mission College in 2005-2007. I acted as an Lab Assistant to Chief Don Kendall. We taught the Wild Land Fire 67 CERT. I demonstrated wild land suppression techniques working in concert with CAL FIRE employees using CAI FIRE equipment to familiarize students with tools of the trade.

I was employed at Rebekah Children's Services where I was a Compadre, Instructor and Advocate for Special Needs Students and families. I worked in various alternative schools and with group homes, mostly in the Gilroy area until the year 2000.
