Adopt a Resolution honoring the **North County Steering Committee for Safe Routes to School** for their formative role in the participatory budgeting process between the)
Transportation Agency for Monterey County and the County of Monterey.)

WHEREAS, the participatory budgeting process consisted of four elements: creating the ballot, planning an election strategy plan, conducting voting, and publishing election results; and

WHEREAS, Steering Committee members attended monthly three-hour meetings for a year, designing the election process and leading outreach for the community election; and

WHEREAS, the ballot included proposals for street projects that would make it safer and more comfortable for students and families to get to and from schools in five communities within North County, and a total of 999 community members voted for their favorite proposals; and

WHEREAS, TAMC will provide a grant up to \$1,000,000 to implement projects that come out of the participatory budgeting process, of which \$781,500 will fund projects on County roadways and \$218,500 of which will fund projects on school district property.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Monterey Board of Supervisors hereby recognize and honor the North County Steering Committee for Safe Routes to School for their dedication to the safety of families as they support their students getting safely to school.
