WHEREAS, Salinas Police Chief **Kelly J. McMillin** is retiring after serving his community for over 32 years; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** began his law enforcement career in 1984 as a Deputy with the San Benito County Sheriff's Department. In 1986, he transferred to the San Diego County Sheriff's Department; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** joined the Salinas Police Department in 1988 as a Salinas Police Officer working patrol. Kelly has also worked in several gang units, as a Detective in the Investigations Division, Detective in the Vice/Narcotics Unit, Administration and various assignments. He was a SWAT operator, team leader and tactical commander; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** has held the ranks of Officer, Corporal, Sergeant, Lieutenant, Commander and Deputy Chief; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** was appointed Chief of the Salinas Police Department on June 11, 2012 and was the first Chief promoted from within the ranks since 1965; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** since becoming a police officer has earned his Associate's Degree from Hartnell College, his BA from Saint Mary's College of California and his Master of Public Policy from the Panetta Institute at California State University Monterey Bay; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** is a 2003 graduate of the 213th session of the FBI National Academy at Quantico, Virginia. In 2012 Kelly was recognized by the White House as a "Champion of Change" for his work in youth violence prevention; and,

WHEREAS, **Kelly J. McMillin** and his wife Teresa have one son, Liam, who is a Cadet at the United States Military Academy at West Point.


