WHEREAS, DOTTIE DODGION appeared numerous times on television over the years: including appearances on the Dick Cavett Show, the Dave Garroway Show and The Today Show,

WHEREAS, DOTTIE DODGION still plays at least every week – on Thursday evenings at the Inn at Spanish Bay – with younger greats like Gary Meek at the piano and Steve Uccello on bass – inspiring us all with her incredible energy, her great knowledge and love of jazz and her perfect set list,
