WHEREAS, Senate Bill 82, known as the Investment in Mental Health Wellness Act of 2013 ("IMHWA"), was established and approved by the Governor on June 27, 2013 to provide Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) funds to assist selected counties in the provision of mental health crisis intervention, stabilization, treatment, services and support to children, adults, and families in Monterey County; and

WHEREAS, the State of California Health Facilities Financing Authority Act authorizes the State of California Health Facilities Financing Authority (CHFFA) to provide these funds under the IMHWA; and

WHEREAS, on or about June 30, 2014, the Monterey County Health Department, Behavioral Health Bureau ("Bureau") received an award letter in the amount of \$193,615.80 from CHFFA ("CHFFA Grant"); and

WHEREAS, the CHFFA Grant, if accepted by the Monterey County Health Department, would provide financial support for the Bureau's new Mobile Crisis Support Program, designed to serve children, adults and families in Monterey County who are experiencing a psychiatric crisis and are at risk of hospital, emergency room, or law enforcement intervention; and

WHEREAS, as a prerequisite to receiving funding, the Board of Supervisors must authorize the Monterey County Health Department to accept the CHFFA Grant; and

WHEREAS, the County Board of Supervisors desires to enter a Grant Agreement with CHFFA in order to accept grant funds for the purposes set forth in that agreement:
