**PROCLAMATION TERMINATING A LOCAL EMERGENCY
BY THE MONTEREY COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Resolution No. 16-308

In the Matter of Proclaiming the Existence)
of a Local Emergency within Monterey County)
Dated October 18, 2016 (4/5th vote required.....)

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the California Emergency Services Act (Government Code section 8550 et seq.) establishes procedures for proclaiming emergencies and for responding promptly to the needs that arise during emergencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 2.68.060 of the Monterey County Code and Section 8630 of the Government Code empower the County Administrative Officer or his designee to proclaim the existence of a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2016, the Soberanes Fire broke out in the Garrapata State Park area of Monterey County and quickly spread and destroyed numerous residences and over 100,000 acres of valuable forest and watershed; and resulted in evacuations and displacement of residents, road closures, areas of isolation, damage to property, utility systems, and critical infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2016, the County Administrative Officer signed an emergency proclamation, which was ratified and extended by the Board of Supervisors on July 26, 2016, and further extended on August 23, 2016 and September 20, 2016; and

WHEREAS, on October 18, 2016, this Board adopted Resolution No. 16-271 extending the Proclamation of Local Emergency; and

WHEREAS, periodic reports consistent with law have been made; and

WHEREAS, the fire was declared by the US Forest Service to be 100% contained on October 13, 2016 with no further immediate peril to lives or property;

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services determined that the incident period for the purposes of immediate disaster relief ended on the containment date of October 13, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors in and for the County of Monterey as follows:

1. The above recitals are true and correct.
2. The local emergency proclaimed by Resolution No. 16-271 is hereby terminated.


