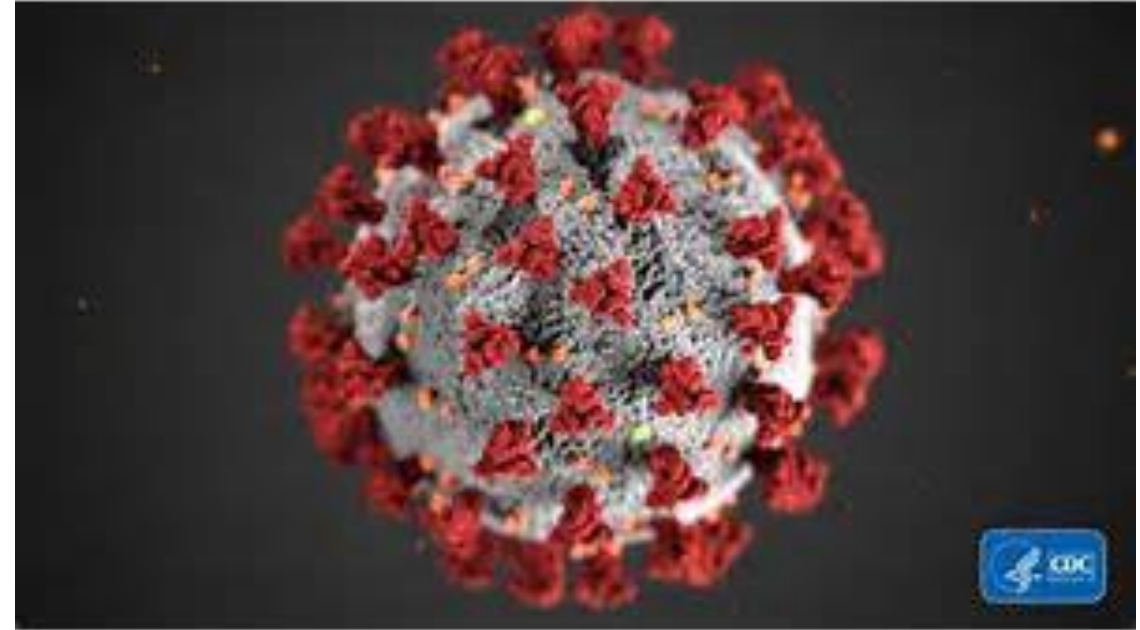

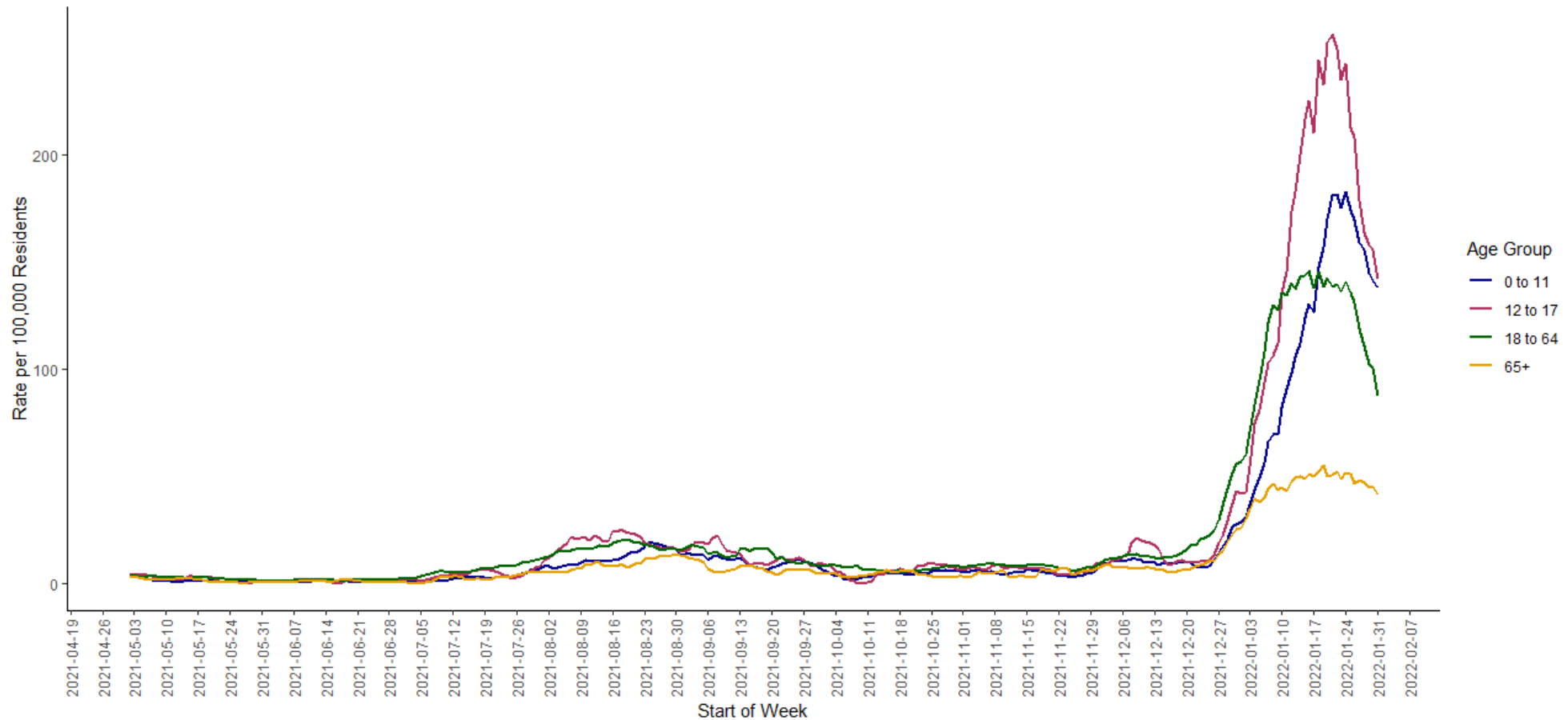

7-day Case Rate per 100,000 Residents by Age Group

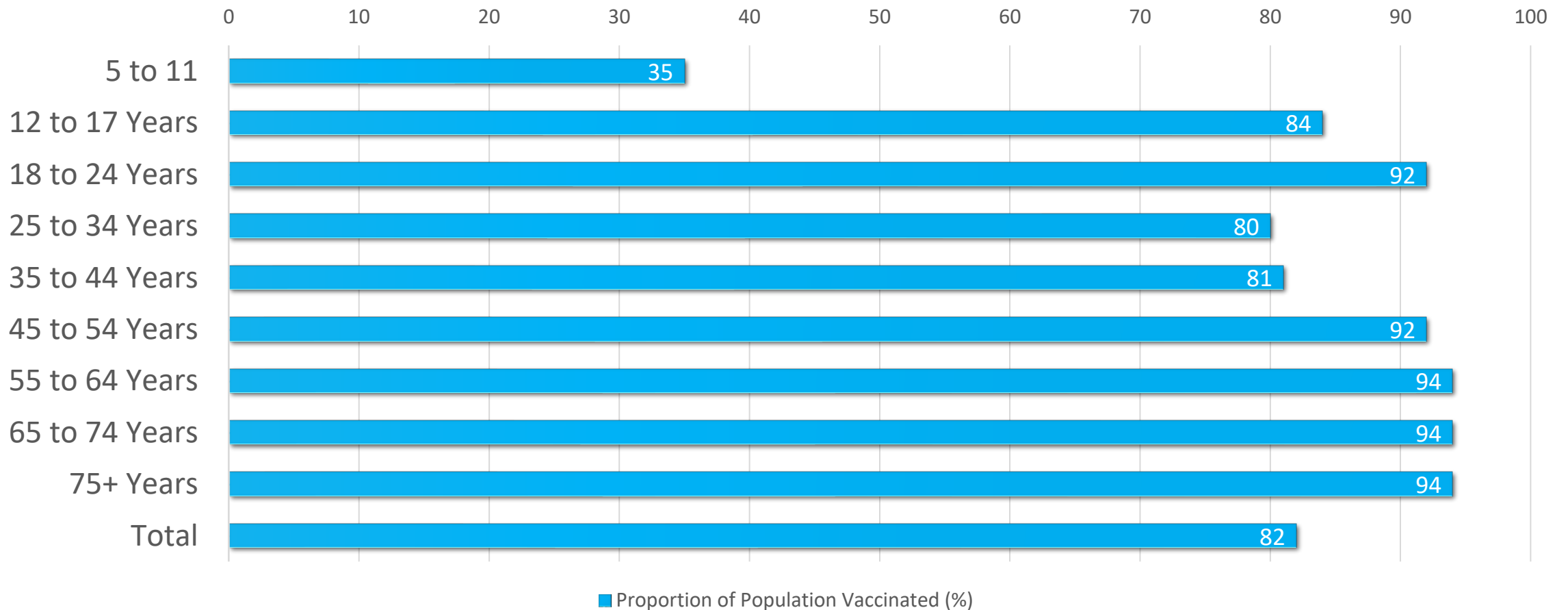

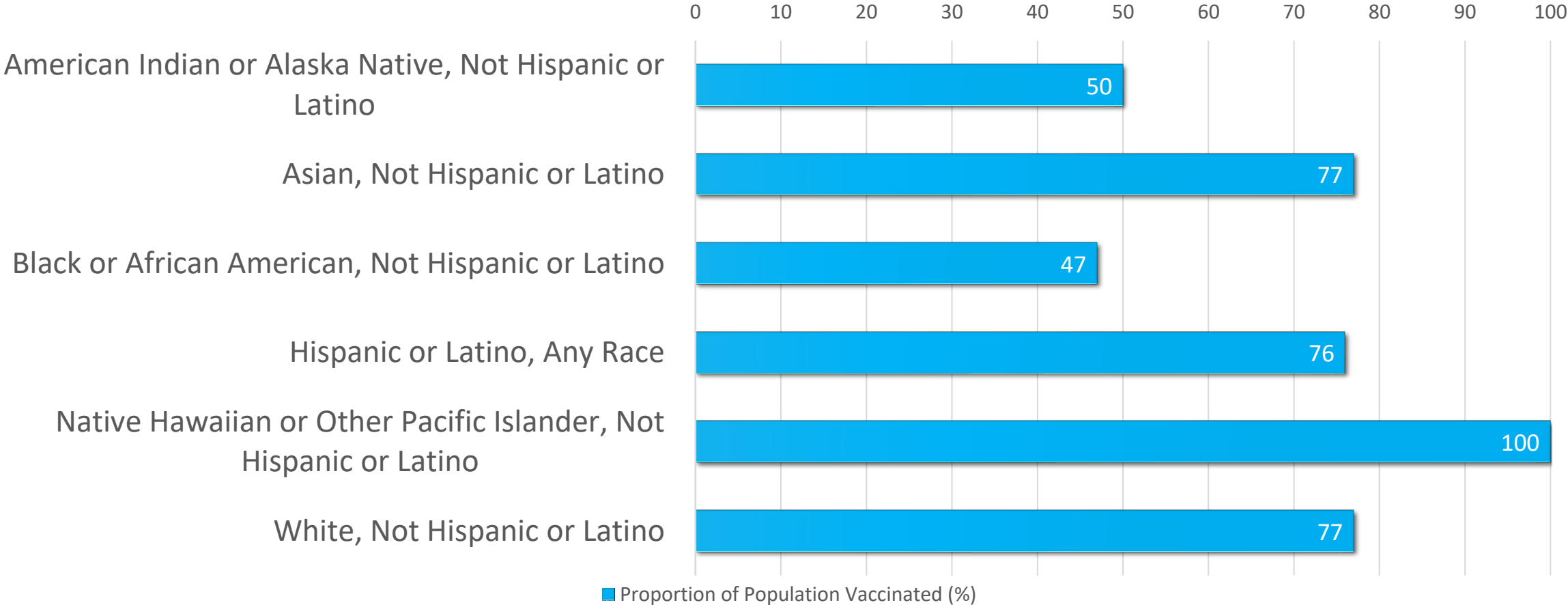

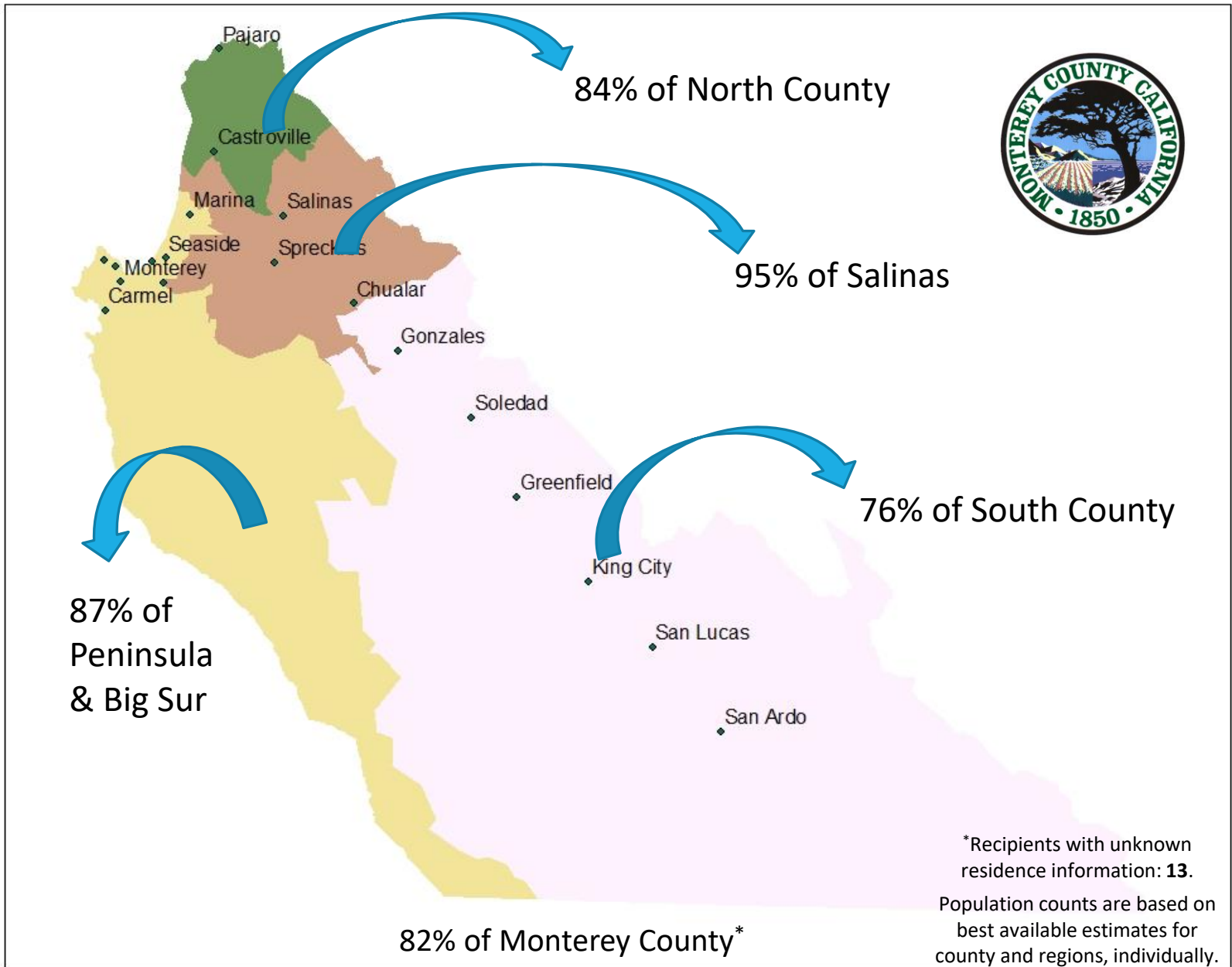


Proportion of Population 5+ Receiving at Least One Dose by Age
