**WHEREAS**, Merritt Street is designated as State Highway 183 (SH 183) and under the jurisdiction of the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

**WHEREAS**, on April 18, 2017, the Board of Supervisors approved an appropriation of \$150,000 to design and construct a pedestrian crossing at the intersection of Merritt Street and Crane Street; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works & Facilities Division of Resource Management Agency developed a design for the crossing and submitted an application to Caltrans for Encroachment Permit; and

**WHEREAS**, Caltrans requires a resolution from the Board of Supervisors agreeing to maintain this pedestrian crossing as a condition of approval of the Encroachment Permit; and

**WHEREAS**, Caltrans is working to program funds for improvements along Merritt Street as a pilot under the State Highway Operation and Protection Program (SHOPP). The nature and timing of these improvements is uncertain. However, a potential exists for Caltrans to alter or remove this pedestrian crossing at Merritt Street and Crane Street and subsequently perhaps assume maintenance; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT**, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Monterey hereby:

Agrees to maintain a pedestrian crossing with a rapid rectangular flashing beacon marked crosswalk, and required signage at the intersection of Merritt Street and Crane Street in Castroville until Caltrans alters, removes, or assumes maintenance responsibility for the crossing.
